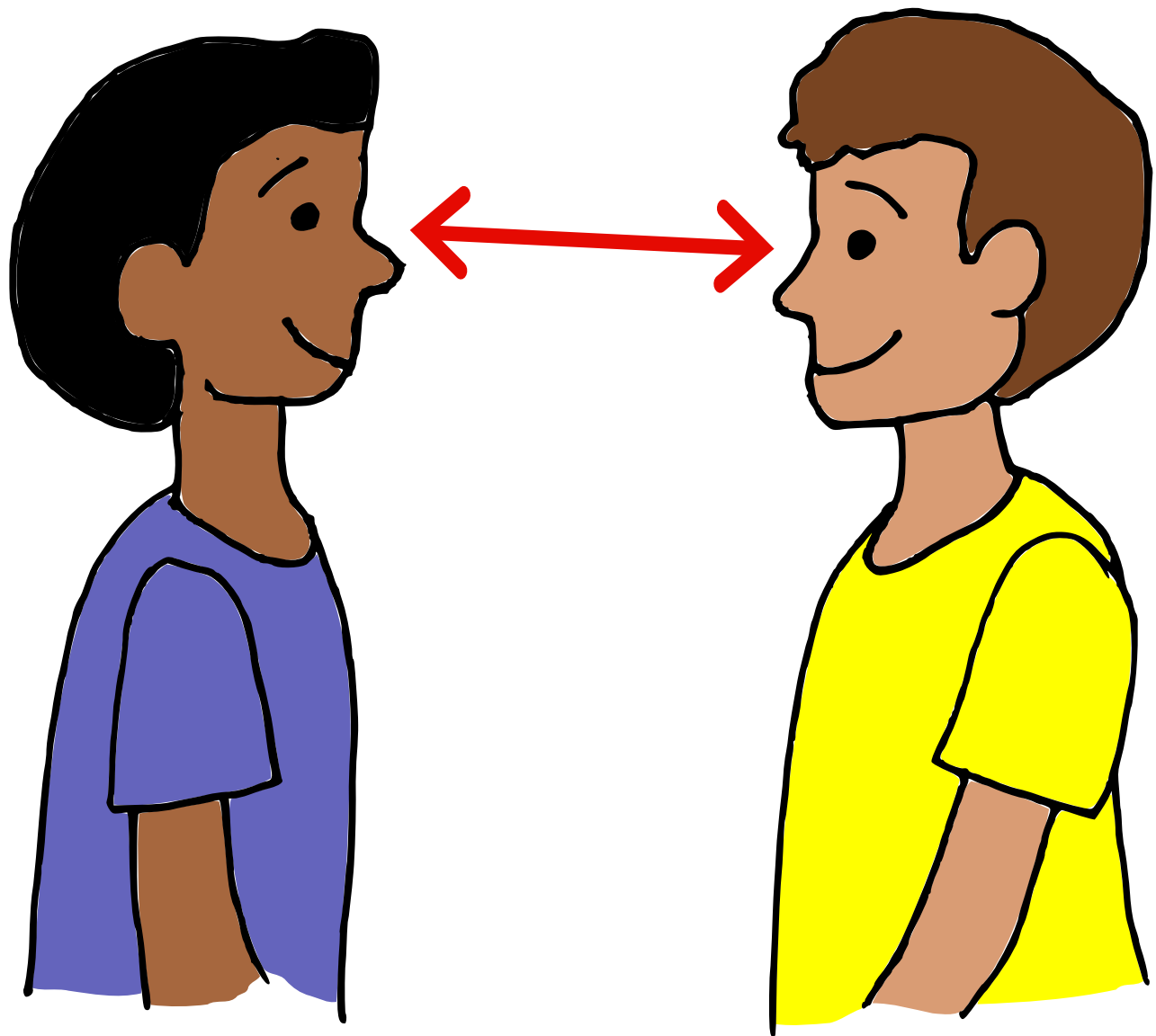


Joining Play

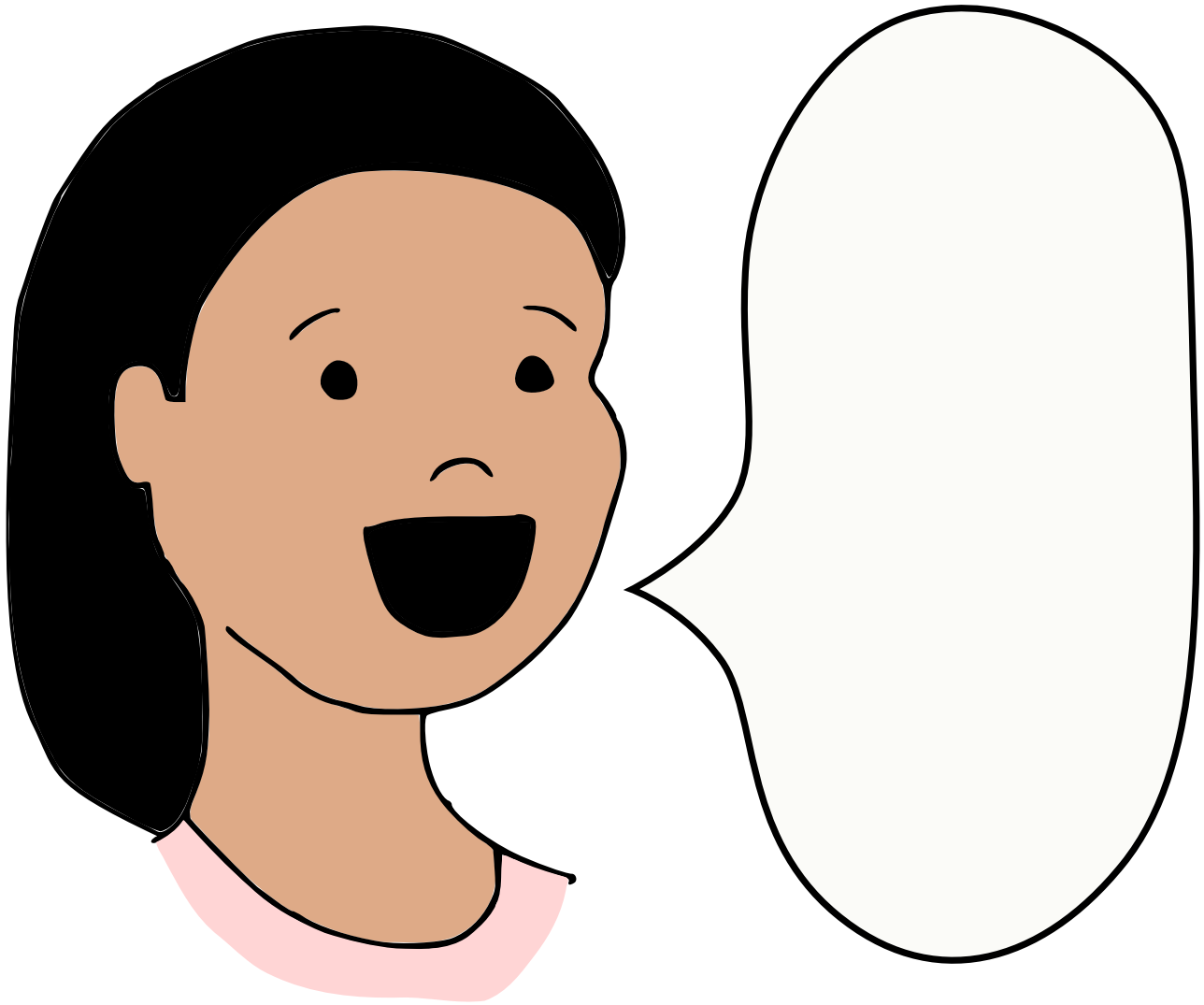




When I see kids playing, I might
want to play too.



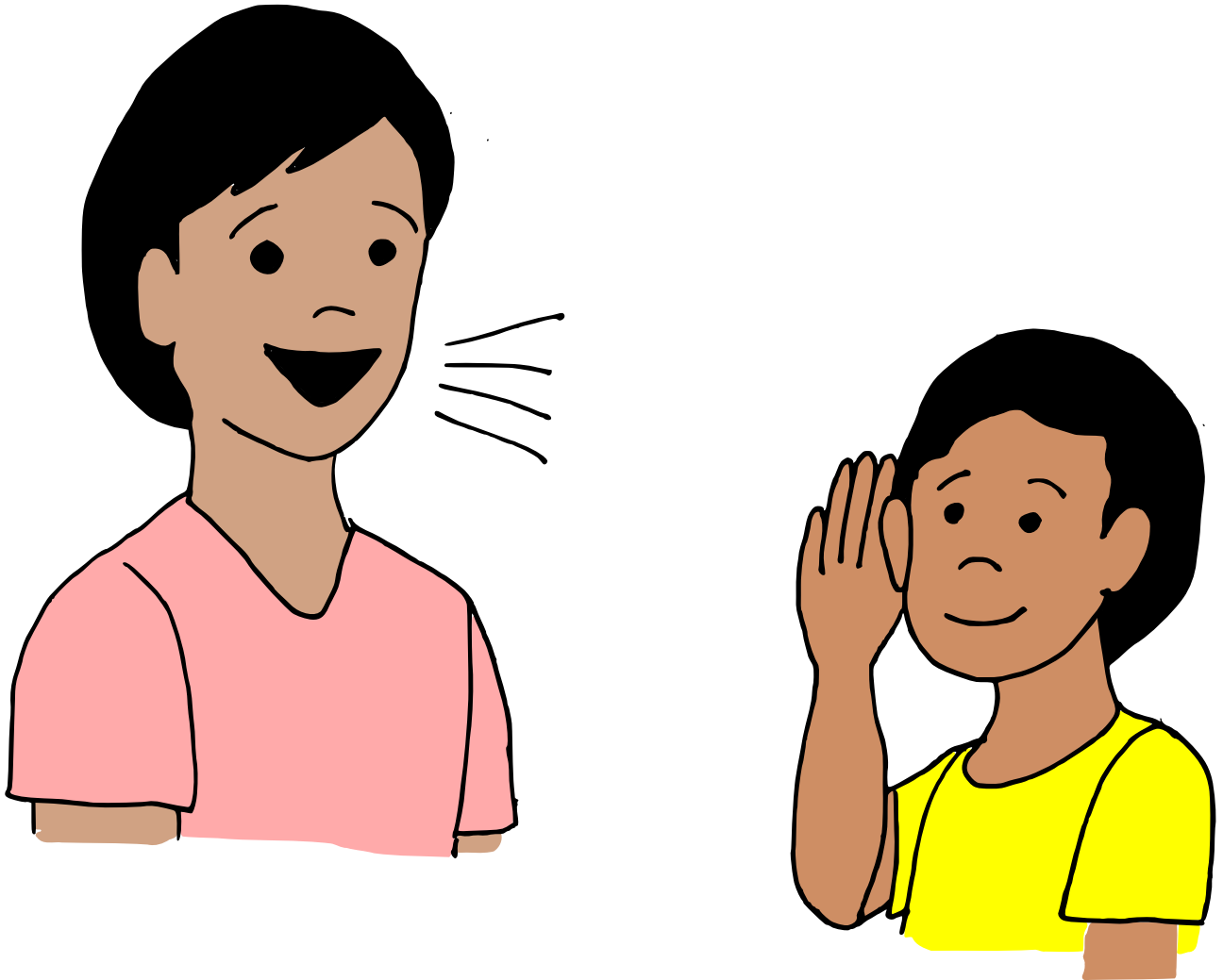
If I want to play with someone- I need to make sure they're looking at me and say "Hi!" first.

"What's your name?"



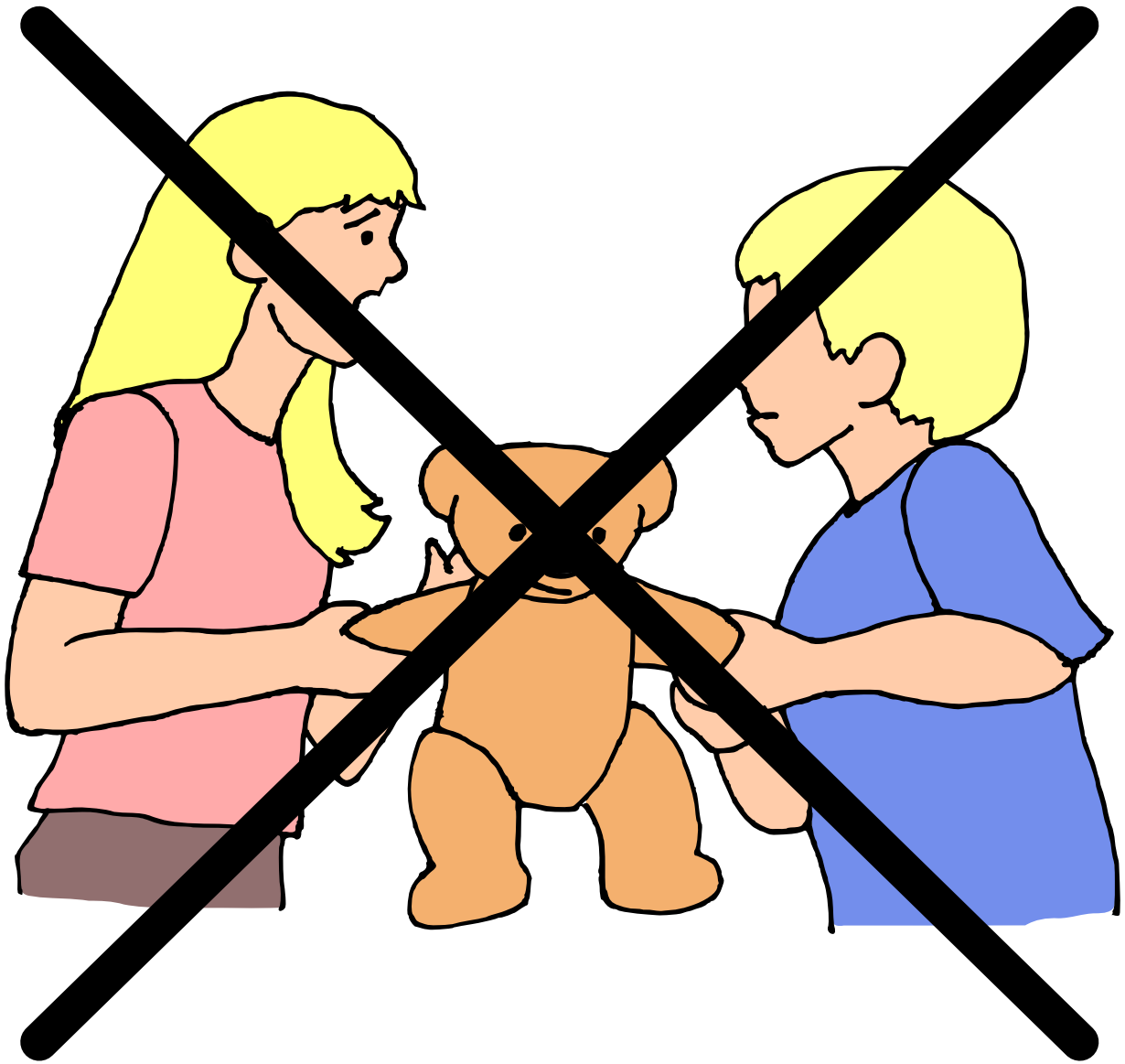
Finally, I can ask if I can join them by saying "Can I play with you?" and listen for their answer.



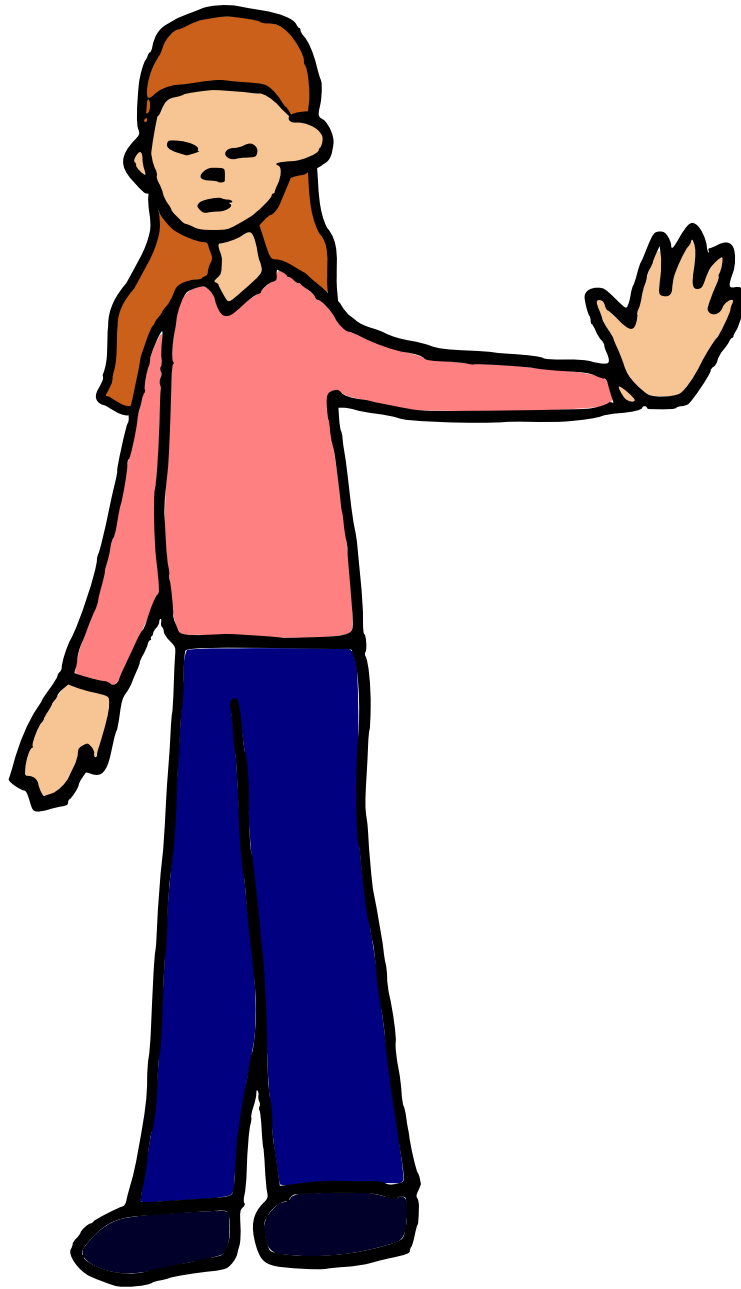
If they say yes, I can start playing
with them.



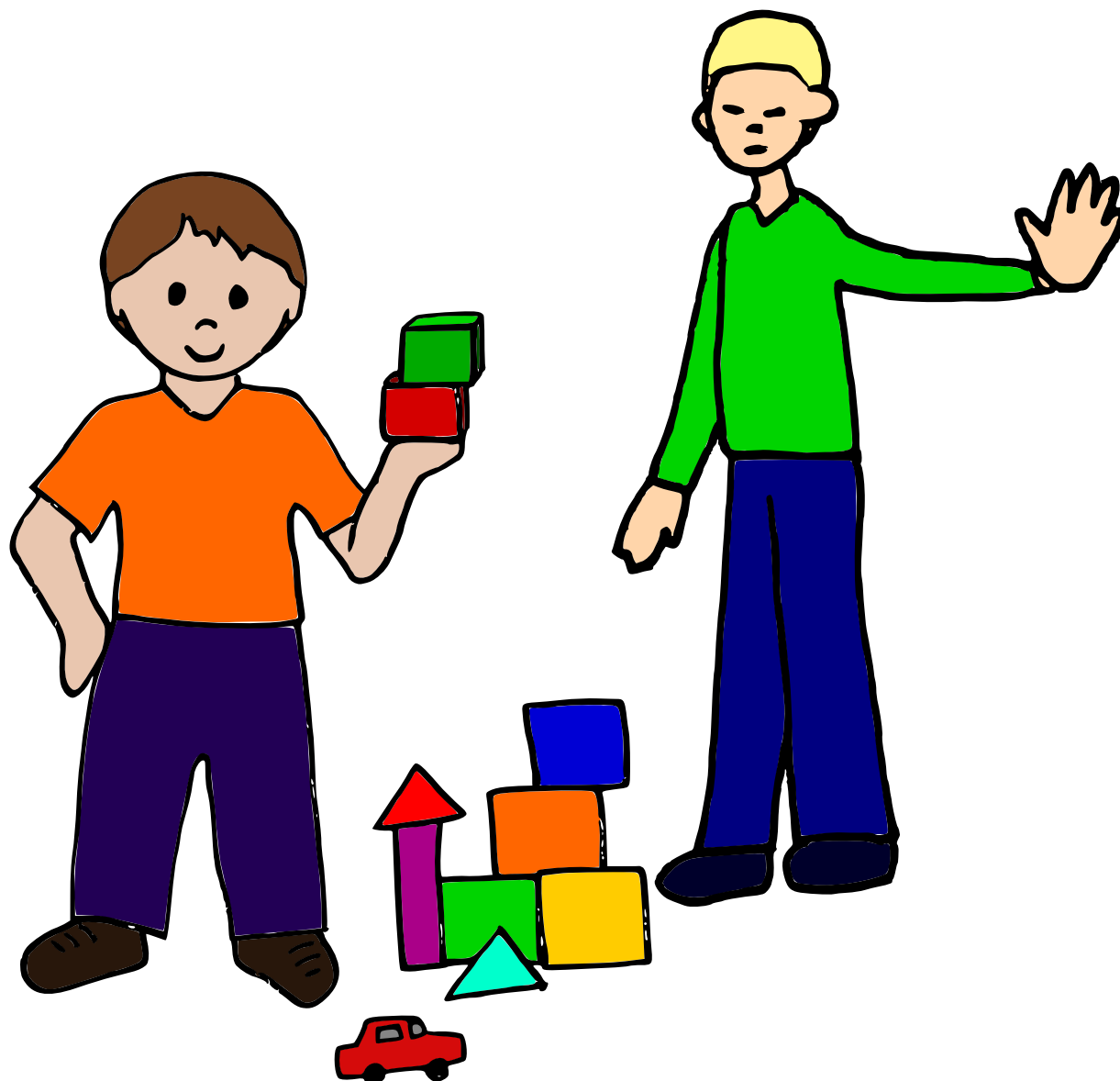
I need to look at what they're doing,
and do it too.



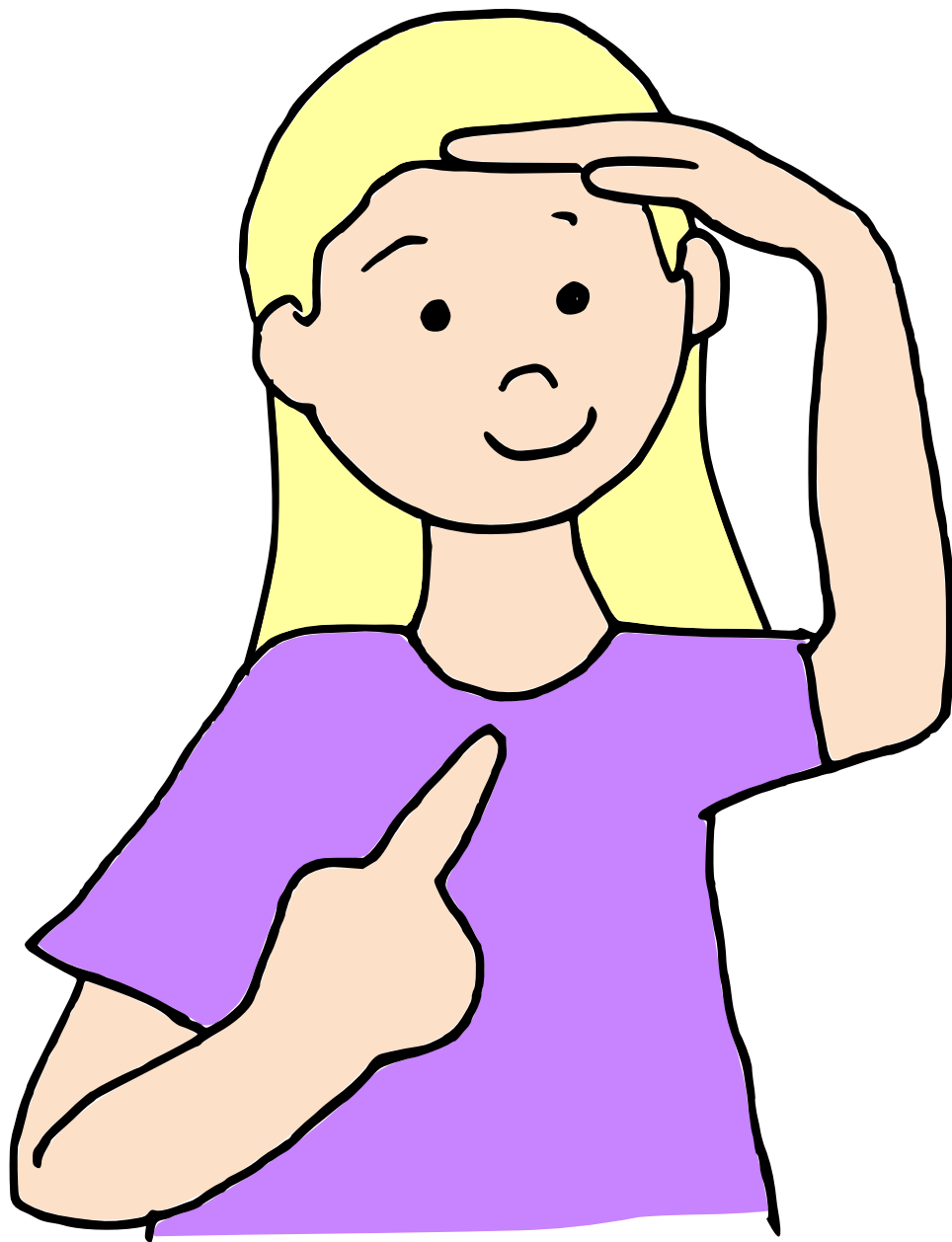
I cannot grab toys or change the game. If I don't know how to play I can ask "How do you play this?"
