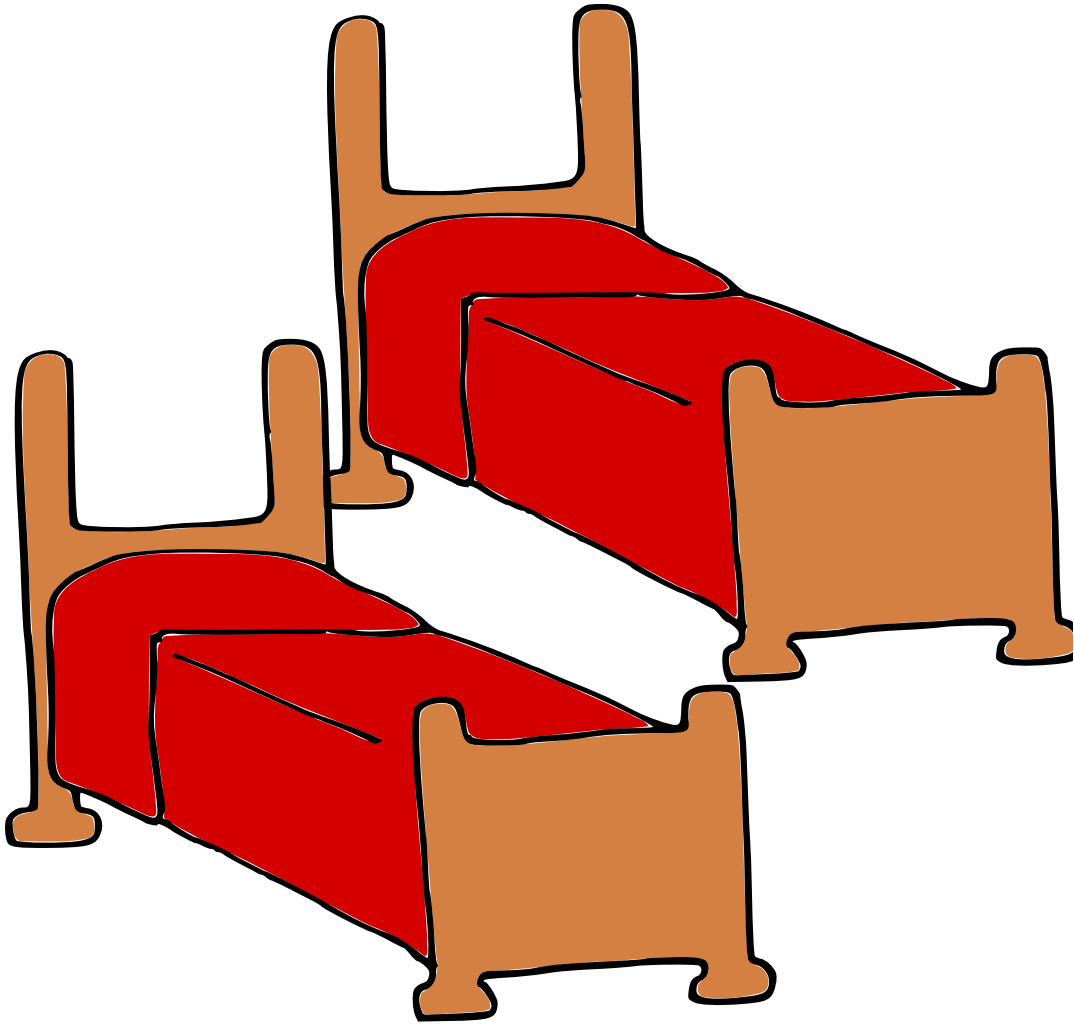
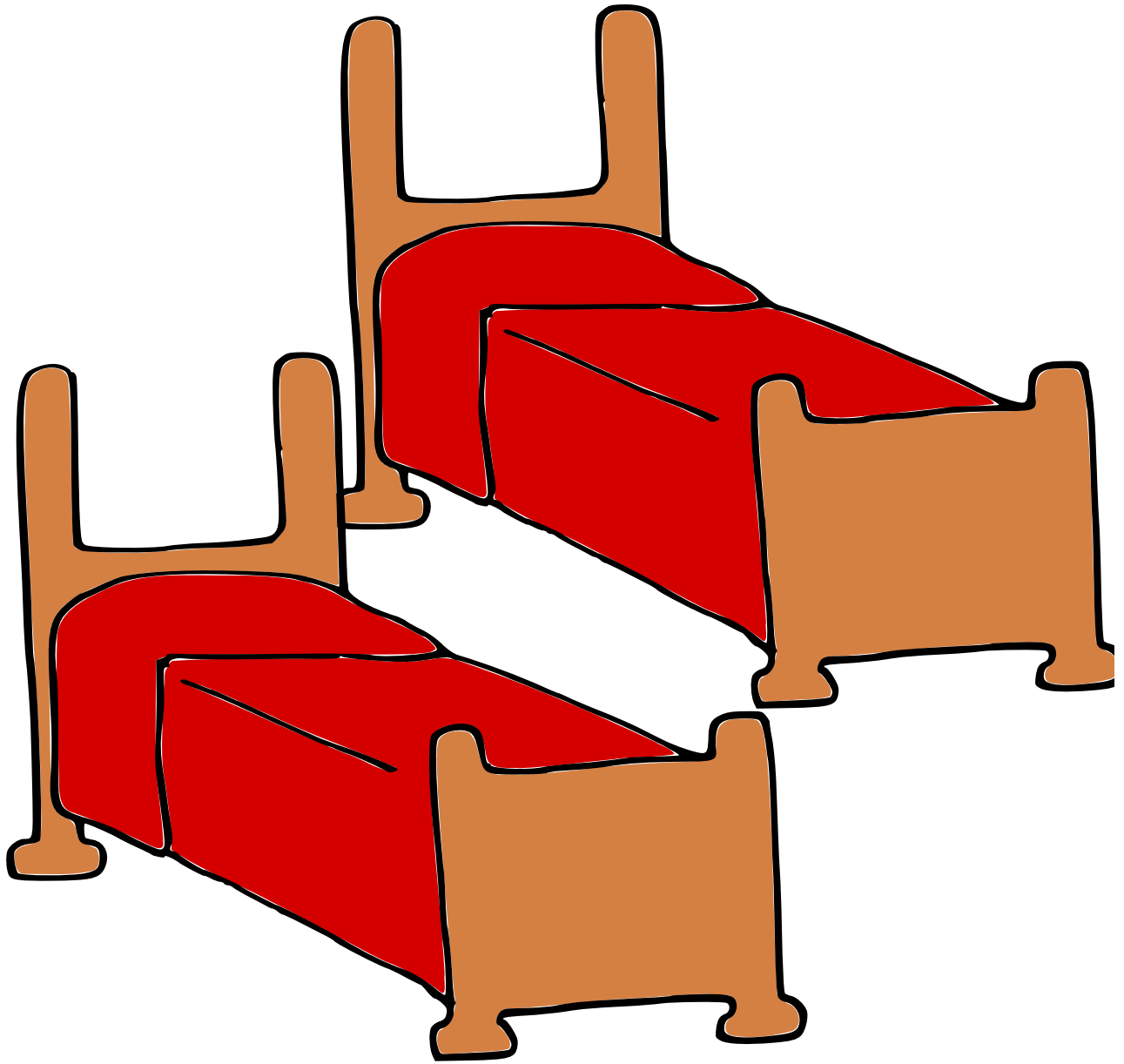


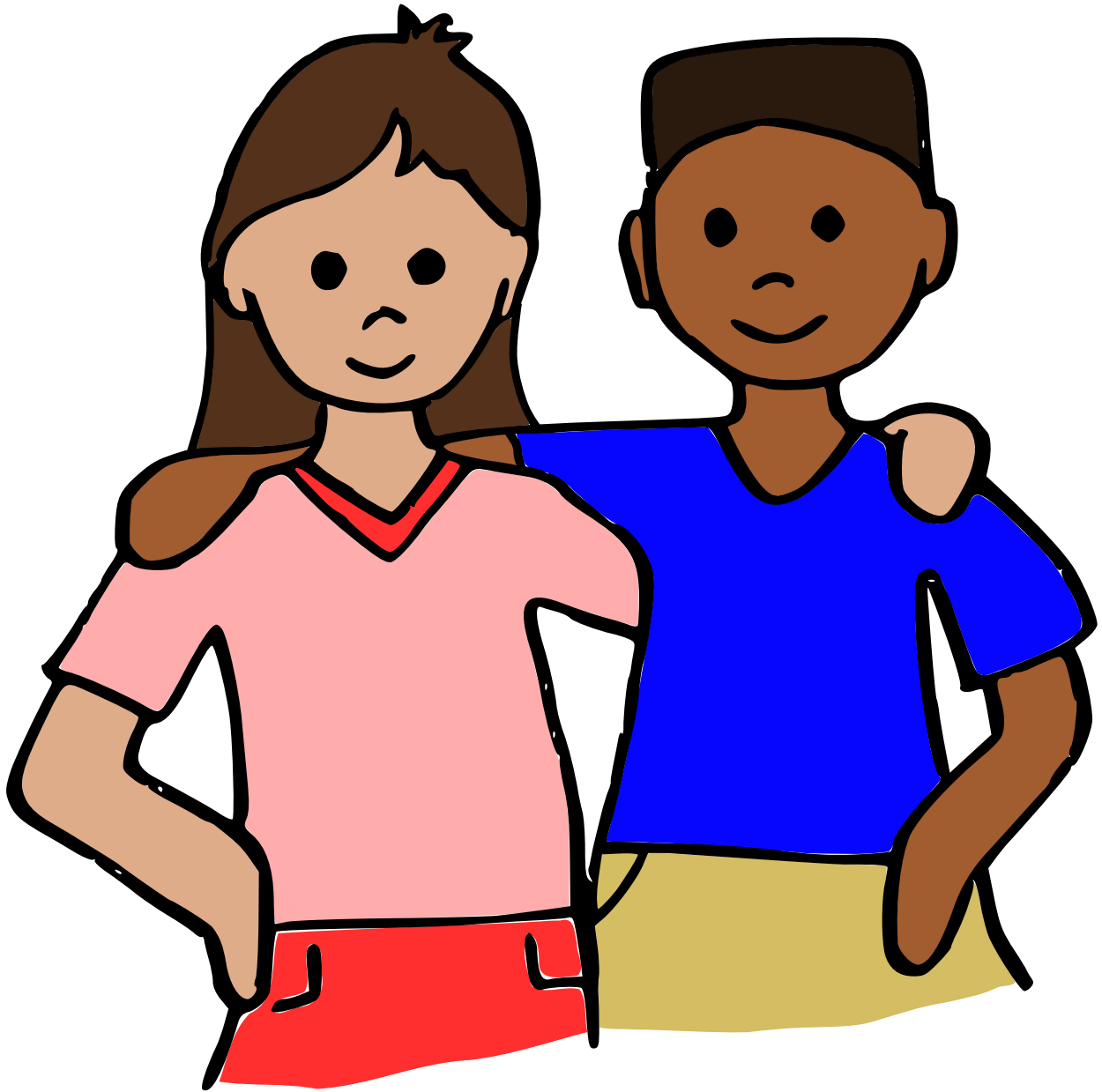
Sharing a Room

5. Clean-up

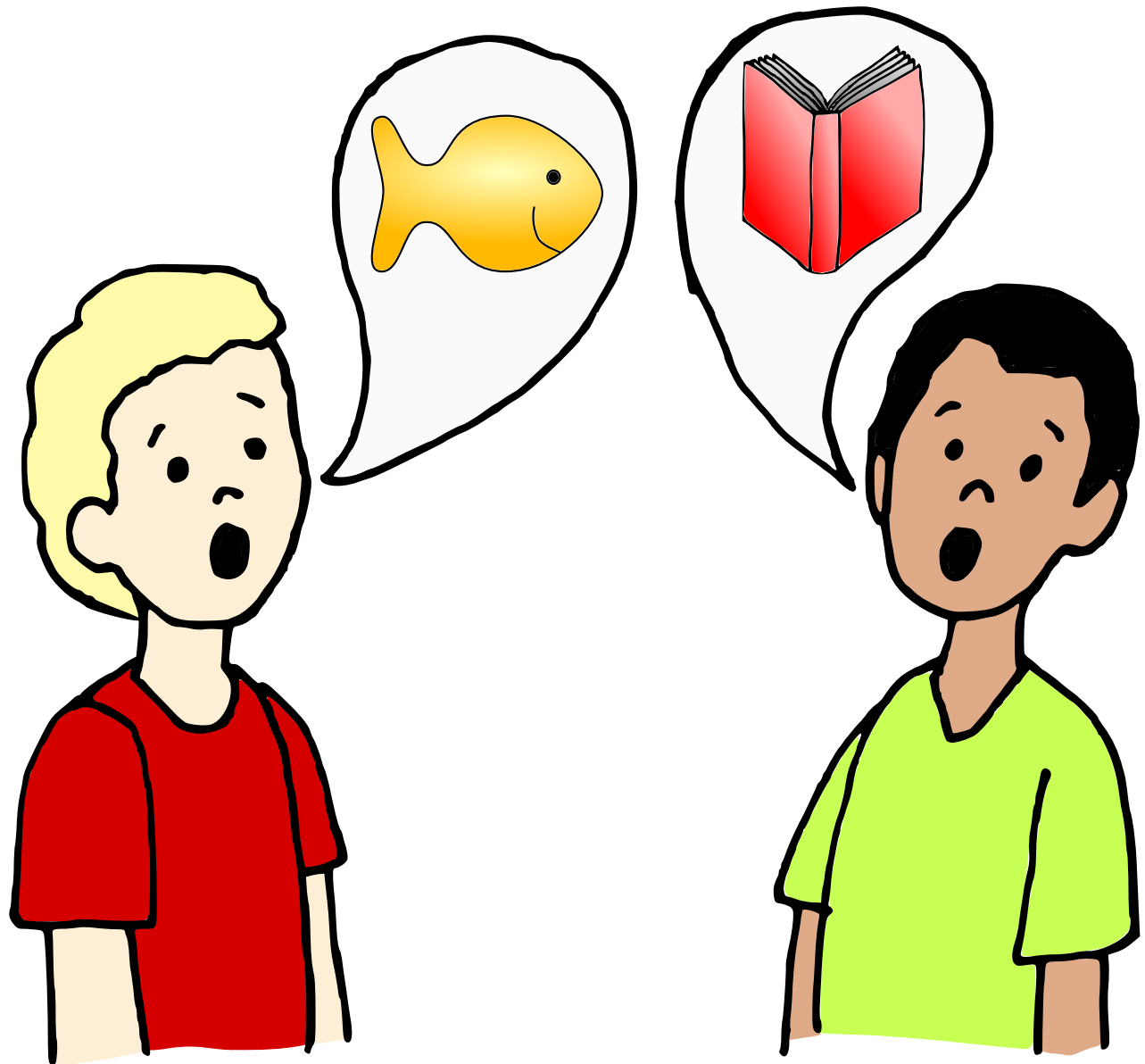
But, there are some rules I need to follow to make sure that everyone sleeps well.



First, I need to stay in my own bed unless my brother/sister asks me to cuddle. If they ask me to get out of their bed, I have to go back to my



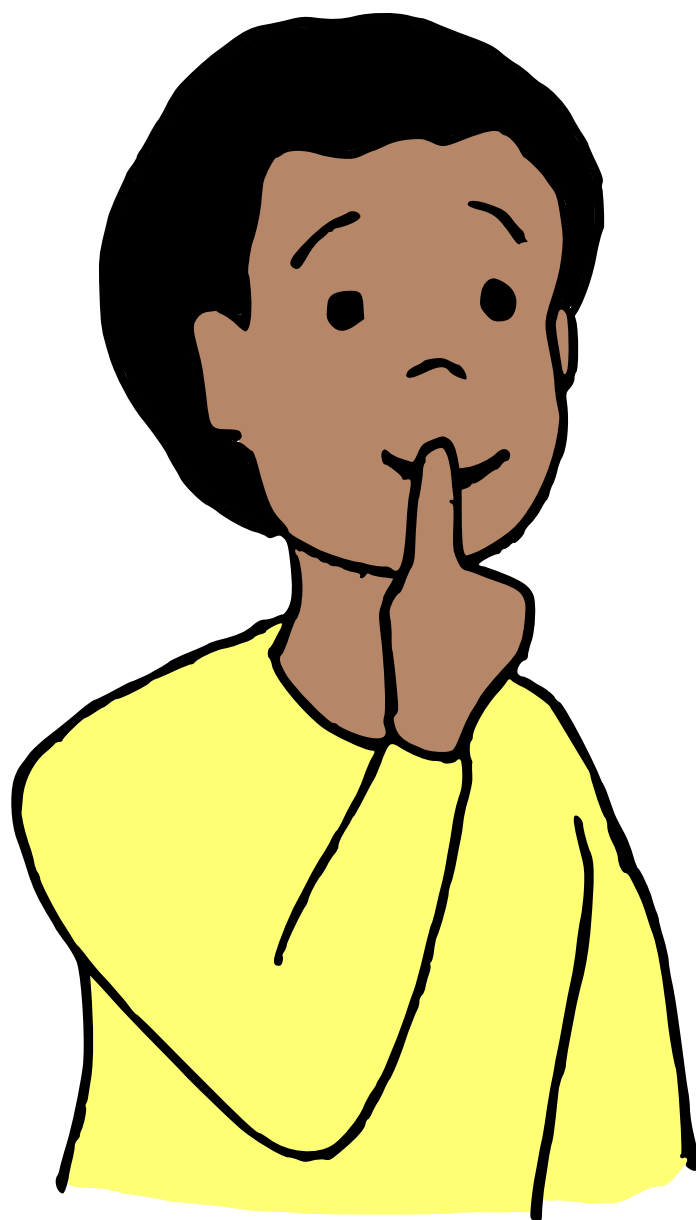
Second, I need to be quiet in the morning when I wake up. If my brother/sister is still sleeping, I can look at a book quietly in my own bed



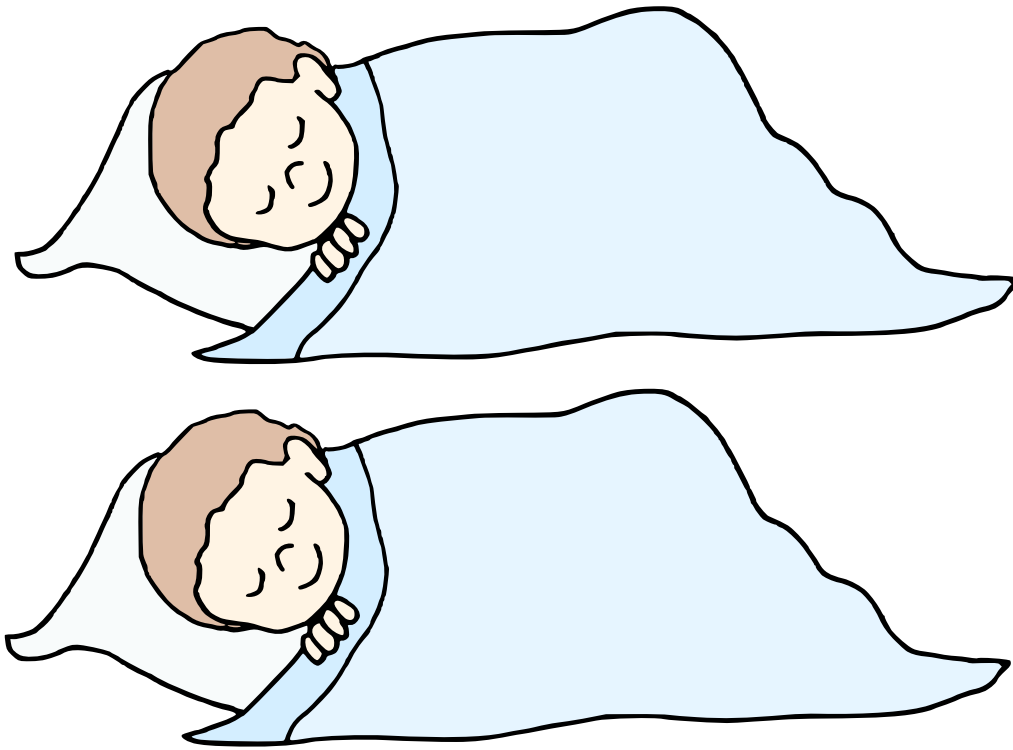
When they wake up, we still need to be quiet until Mom or Dad comes to get us- but we can play quietly together.
