

## Wearing a Mask



Wearing a Mask




There's a new virus going around. It's called COVID-19 or CoronaVirus.

It's important that the mask covers our chin, nose, and mouth.




It's important that, even with the mask on, I can still breathe.




The mask is not a costume.




Even though the mask is covering their mouth, people can still talk.
