ORDER

1. The Review Board having under consideration: (1) the Commission's Order (FCC 71-865, released August 25, 1971), which, inter alia, granted the request of U.S. Communications of Texas, Inc. (KJDO-TV) for reinstatement of its construction permit, call sign and application for an extension of time to complete construction, and designated the application for oral argument before the Review Board; and (2) a statement of U.S. Communications of Texas, Inc., filed on September 3, 1971;

4. IT IS ORDERED, That the application (BMPCT-7308) of U.S. Communications of Texas, Inc. for extension of time to complete construction of Station KJDO-TV IS SEVERED from this proceeding, and IS DENIED, and the construction permit and call letters ARE CANCELED.
