## Introductory



AMES CITY COUNTY was one of the eight original shires into which the Colony of Virginia was divided in 1634. Williamsburg, the present county seat, was at a very early period, the seat of a District Court. It was the capital of the State from the year 1699 until 1779, when the public records were removed to Richmond, which henceforth became the capital of Virginia.

During the Civil War, the court records were removed to Richmond for protection against the vandalism of the Federal troops. This protection was but a temporary one, for the records were almost entirely destroyed in the great fire in Richmond at the evacuation in 1865.

Williamsburg being a Chancery Court, it followed that depositions, court orders, and copies of wills in numerous suits from various counties were deposited there; and it is with the few records that were saved from destruction that this volume treats.

In the present work there will be found abstracts of all wills now on file at the Chancery Court. In a large number of instances, the original records of the counties from which these wills were taken, have been destroyed, and the copies at Williamsburg are the only ones in existence. It is unnecessary, therefore, to enlarge upon their great value to the antiquary and genealogist.

Upon examining the records, it was found that all wills coming under the initial letter A, and a portion under the letter B, were missing. Fortunately, an alphabetical list of the wills had been made by Dr. Lyon G. Tyler, President of



William and Mary College, and Prof. E. J. Stubbs of the same institution. Through the courtesy of the latter gentleman, I have been able to make use of this list, thereby supplying the name of the testator, and the dates of the missing wills.

I feel assured that the loss of these records—fortunately only a small number—is but a temporary one, and that they will eventually be recovered. When this is accomplished, they will be printed and sent gratis to all the subscribers to this volume.
