FAQ

Q1: Why does the UEFI download include two separate tools: UEFI HII and UEFI CLI?

A1:

Though both utilities can be used to configure RAID arrays, there are several important differences:

The **UEFI HII** utility will add HighPoint RAID creation menus to the motherboard's BIOS interface. However, this is not compatible with all systems. This utility requires that the most recent UEFI ROM has been loaded for the product, and can only be used with motherboards/computers that support Third-Party HII capable devices, such as HighPoint RocketRAID and SSD7xxx series controllers.

The **UEFI CLI** Tool can be used with any system that has UEFI BIOS mode support. It is also used to update the UEFI ROM (the UEFI HII utility does not have this ability).
