18 After considering the memorandum of points and authorities and attached exhibits, declarations
19 of officers, Request for Judicial Notice of Criminal Convictions, and all pleadings, papers, files and
20 records on file herein, this Court finds by clear and convincing evidence that the conduct of defendant
21 Bounty Hunters and its members constitutes a public nuisance in the Safety Zone; and therefore, good
22 cause appearing,

23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

24 1. Defendant Bounty Hunters, its members, including but not limited to Aubrey Anderson,
25 George Anderson, Billy Barnes, Rayshawn Boyce, Dontae Carrell, Brandon Crosby, Ronnie Geter,
26 Pervis Henderson, Jr., Duane Hull, Kemal Hutcherson, Israel Jauregui, Edward Jones, Jr., Rodney Laird,
27 Donte McDaniel, Pattie Paschal and Andre Pickens, and all persons acting under, in concert with, for the
28 benefit of, at the direction of, or in association with them or any of them, are restrained and enjoined

1 from, engaging in or performing, directly or indirectly, any of the following activities in the Safety Zone
2 (attached as Exhibit 1), bounded by 108th Street to the north, Central Avenue to the west, Imperial
3 Highway to the south, the rail line of Los Angeles Metropolitan Transit Authority Blue Line (Metro
4 Blue Line) to the east, and extending 100 yards to the outside of each of these four boundaries:

5 a. **Do Not Associate:** Standing, sitting, walking, driving, gathering or appearing
6 anywhere in public view, in a public place or in anyplace accessible to the public, with any other known
7 Bounty Hunter gang member, including but not limited to the individuals depicted in the photographs
8 attached as Exhibit 2. This prohibition shall not apply in either of the following situations: (1) when all
9 individuals are inside a school attending class or on school business or (2) when all are inside a church
10 or religious institution for purposes of worship; provided, however, that this prohibition against
11 associating shall apply to all methods of travel to and from any of those locations;

12 b. **No Intimidation:** Confronting, intimidating, annoying, harassing, threatening,
13 challenging, provoking, assaulting or battering any person who lives, works, visits or passes through the
14 Safety Zone or any person known to be a witness to, or victim of, any Bounty Hunter activity or any
15 person known to have complained about any Bounty Hunter activity;

16 c. **No Guns or Illegal Weapons:** (1) Possessing any gun, ammunition or illegal
17 weapon as described in Penal Code section 12020, whether or not concealed, while in public view, in a
18 public place or in anyplace accessible to the public, (2) knowingly remaining in the presence of anyone
19 who is in possession of such gun, ammunition or illegal weapon while in public view, in a public place
20 or in anyplace accessible to the public, or (3) knowingly remaining in the presence of such gun,
21 ammunition or illegal weapon while in public view, in a public place or in anyplace accessible to the
22 public;

23 d. **Stay Away From Drugs:** (1) Selling, possessing or using, without a prescription,
24 any controlled substance or marijuana, or related paraphernalia, including, but not limited to, rolling
25 papers and pipes used for illegal drug use, (2) knowingly remaining in the presence of anyone selling,
26 possessing or using, without a prescription, any controlled substance or marijuana, or such related
27 paraphernalia, or (3) knowingly remaining in the presence of any controlled substance or marijuana, or
28 such related paraphernalia;

1 e. **No Lookouts:** Acting as a lookout by whistling, yelling, or otherwise signaling,
2 by any means, to warn another person engaged in unlawful or nuisance activity of the approach of law
3 enforcement officers, or soliciting, encouraging, coercing or employing another person to act as such
4 lookout;

5 f. **No Hooks:** Acting as a hook by approaching, signaling or otherwise attracting
6 another individual for the purpose of drug sales, or soliciting, encouraging, coercing or employing
7 another person to act as such hook;

8 g. **No Obstructing Traffic:** Obstructing, impeding or blocking the free passage of
9 any person or vehicle on any street, walkway, sidewalk, driveway, alley, parking lot or other area of
10 public access;

11 h. **No Blocking Parking:** Blocking or using parking spaces assigned to residents of
12 Nickerson Gardens;

13 i. **Stay Away From Alcohol:** Drinking or possessing an open container of an
14 alcoholic beverage in public view, in a public place or in anyplace accessible to the public;

15 j. **No Graffiti or Vandalism Tools:** Damaging, defacing, marking, painting or
16 otherwise applying graffiti on any public or private property, or possessing any aerosol paint container,
17 felt tip marker or other marking substances that can be used to paint, spray paint, etch, mark, draw or
18 otherwise apply graffiti;

19 k. **No Loitering:** Loitering in public view, in a public place or in anyplace
20 accessible to the public for the purpose of engaging in graffiti, drug-related activity or any other illegal
21 purpose;

22 l. **No Trespassing:** Being present in Nickerson Gardens Housing Development or
23 being present on or in any property not open to the general public, except (1) with the prior written
24 consent of the owner, owner's agent or person in lawful possession of the property or (2) in the presence
25 of and with the voluntary consent of the owner, owner's agent or person in lawful possession of the
26 property; and

1 m. **No Gambling:** Gambling, including, but not limited to, the playing of cards,
2 dominoes, dice, or dog fighting for money, in public view, in a public place or in anyplace accessible to
3 the public.
