15 Plaintiff, the People of the State of California, acting by and through James K. Hahn, as the
16 City Attorney of the City of Los Angeles, filed a complaint on November 12, 1999, seeking a "gang
17 injunction" against defendant Harbor City and defendant Harbor City Crips, two unincorporated
18 associations alleged to be criminal street gangs, and against certain named individual defendants
19 alleged to be gang members, in a "Safety Zone" (a map of which is included as page 6) bounded by
20 Western Avenue to the west, Pacific Coast Highway to the south, Vermont Avenue to the east, and
21 Lomita Boulevard to the north, and extending 100 yards to the outside of each of those four streets,
22 and also including the Harbor City Recreational Center also known as Frampton Park north-west of
23 Lomita Boulevard and Frampton Avenue, in the City of Los Angeles; plaintiff subsequently
24 voluntarily dismissed without prejudice five unserved and one dead defendant, and dismissed all
25 unnamed fictitious defendants; defaults have been duly entered against all defendants not dismissed;

26 After due consideration of all papers filed in this action, including the moving papers and
27 evidence submitted in support of plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction, the deemed
28 admissions of the defaulting defendants, and the authorities presented by counsel including People

1 ex rel. Gallo v. Acuna, 14 Cal. 4th 1090, cert. denied, 521 U.S. 1121 (1997), and In re Englebrecht,
2 67 Cal. App. 4th 436 (1998), this Court makes the following findings of fact:

3 With respect to defendant Harbor City and its members: (1) Harbor City is a
4 criminal street gang as defined in Penal Code § 186.22; (2) the conduct of defendant Harbor City and
5 its members constitutes a public nuisance in the Safety Zone; (3) each of the following named
6 defendants: Armando Alvarado Jr. (Gremlin/Stalker), Gregory Michael Bourdeau (Flaco/Silent),
7 Ivan Arturo Briviesca (Chubbs/Clumsy), David Escobar (Lil Evil), Ruben Joseph Esqueda (Lil
8 Ruben), Fernando Lozano (Lil Creeper), Leroy John Martinez (Oso), Armando Elias Micro
9 (Chile/Spanky), Andy Orlando Perez (Shorty), Sammy Perez (Ghost/Casper), Richard N. Ramirez
10 (Bandit), Octavio Rivas (Dirt/Loner), Luis Gerardo Ruiz (Big Boy/Stretch), Sergio Ruiz (Lil Bullet),
11 Refujio Valencia (Gremlin/Jay-R), and Raymond Frankie Velasquez (Traviso/Lumpy), is a member
12 of Harbor City, and shall be referred to collectively at times hereafter as "Named Harbor City
13 Gang Members"; (4) each Named Harbor City Gang Member has been observed in the Safety Zone,
14 and (5) each Named Harbor City Gang Member is responsible in some manner for the nuisance
15 complained of by Plaintiff; and

16 With respect to defendant Harbor City Crips and its members: (1) Harbor City
17 Crips is a criminal street gang as defined in Penal Code § 186.22; (2) the conduct of defendant
18 Harbor City Crips and its members constitutes a public nuisance in the Safety Zone; (3) each of the
19 following named defendants: Deandre Demarshon Anderson (D), Samuel Lynn Collins (Sammy),
20 John Douglas Edmond Jr. (Lil J-Loc), Malcolm Jerome Johnson Jr. (Lil Juice), Julius Roschon Jones
21 (Tiny T), Damu Stadi Scott (D-Loc), Majon Lafayette Scott (Lil One), and Thomas Turnage
22 (Scrappy/Outlaw), is a member of Harbor City Crips, and shall be referred to collectively at times
23 hereafter as "Named Harbor City Crips Gang Members"; (4) each Named Harbor City Crips
24 Gang Member has been observed in the Safety Zone, and (5) each Named Harbor City Crips Gang
25 Member is responsible in some manner for the nuisance complained of by Plaintiff; and

26 Good cause appearing for entry of judgment,

27 **IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that:

28 1. a. Harbor City Gang (Do Not Associate): Defendant Harbor City, all members

1 of Harbor City including but not limited to Armando Alvarado Jr. (Gremlin/Stalker), Gregory
2 Michael Bourdeau (Flaco/Silent), Ivan Arturo Briviesca (Chubbs/Clumsy), David Escobar (Lil Evil),
3 Ruben Joseph Esqueda (Lil Ruben), Fernando Lozano (Lil Creeper), Leroy John Martinez (Oso),
4 Armando Elias Micro (Chile/Spanky), Andy Orlando Perez (Shorty), Sammy Perez (Ghost Casper),
5 Richard N. Ramirez (Bandit), Octavio Rivas (Dirt/Loner), Luis Gerardo Ruiz (Big Boy/Stretch),
6 Sergio Ruiz (Lil Bullet), Refujio Valencia (Gremlin/Jay-R), and Raymond Frankie Velasquez
7 (Traviso/Lumpy), and each of them, are enjoined and restrained from engaging in or performing
8 directly or indirectly, any of the following activities in the Safety Zone: standing, sitting, walking,
9 driving, gathering or appearing, anywhere in public view or anyplace accessible to the public, with
10 any Named Harbor City Gang Member (photographs of whom are included on page 7) or any known
11 member of the Harbor City criminal street gang, but not including when at Bay Harbor Hospital or
12 Kaiser Foundation Hospital for a legitimate purpose;

13 b. **Harbor City Crips Gang (Do Not Associate):** Defendant Harbor City Crips,
14 all members of Harbor City Crips including but not limited to Deandre Demarshon Anderson (D),
15 Samuel Lynn Collins (Sammy), John Douglas Edmond Jr. (Lil J-Loc), Malcolm Jerome Johnson Jr.
16 (Lil Juice), Julius Roschon Jones (Tiny T), Damu Stadi Scott (D-Loc), Majon Lafayette Scott (Lil
17 One), and Thomas Turnage (Scrappy/Outlaw), and each of them, are enjoined and restrained from
18 engaging in or performing directly or indirectly, any of the following activities in the Safety Zone:
19 standing, sitting, walking, driving, gathering or appearing, anywhere in public view or anyplace
20 accessible to the public, with any Named Harbor City Crips Gang Member (photographs of whom
21 are included on page 8) or any known member of the Harbor City Crips criminal street gang, but not
22 including when at Bay Harbor Hospital or Kaiser Foundation Hospital for a legitimate purpose;

23 2. **All Defendants:** Harbor City, all members of Harbor City including all Named
24 Harbor City Gang Members, Harbor City Crips, all members of Harbor City Crips including all
25 Named Harbor City Crips Gang Members, and all persons acting under, in concert with, or for any
26 one of them, are enjoined and restrained from engaging in or performing directly or indirectly, any of
27 the following activities in the Safety Zone:

28 a. **No Witness Intimidation:** Confronting, intimidating, annoying, harassing,

1 threatening, challenging, provoking, assaulting or battering any person known to be a witness to or
2 victim of crime, or any person known to have complained about the gang activities of Harbor City
3 and/or Harbor City Crips;

4 b. **No Guns or Dangerous Weapons:** Anywhere in public view or anyplace
5 accessible to the public, (1) possessing any gun, ammunition, or illegal weapon as defined in Penal
6 Code section 12020, (2) knowingly remaining in the presence of anyone who is in possession of
7 such gun, ammunition or dangerous weapon, or (3) knowingly remaining in the presence of such
8 gun, ammunition or dangerous weapon;

9 c. **Stay Away From Drugs:** Without a prescription, (1) selling, possessing, or
10 using any controlled substance or related paraphernalia, including but not limited to rolling papers
11 and pipes used for illegal drug use, (2) knowingly remaining in the presence of anyone selling,
12 possessing, or using any controlled substance or such related paraphernalia, or (3) knowingly
13 remaining in the presence of any controlled substance or such related paraphernalia;

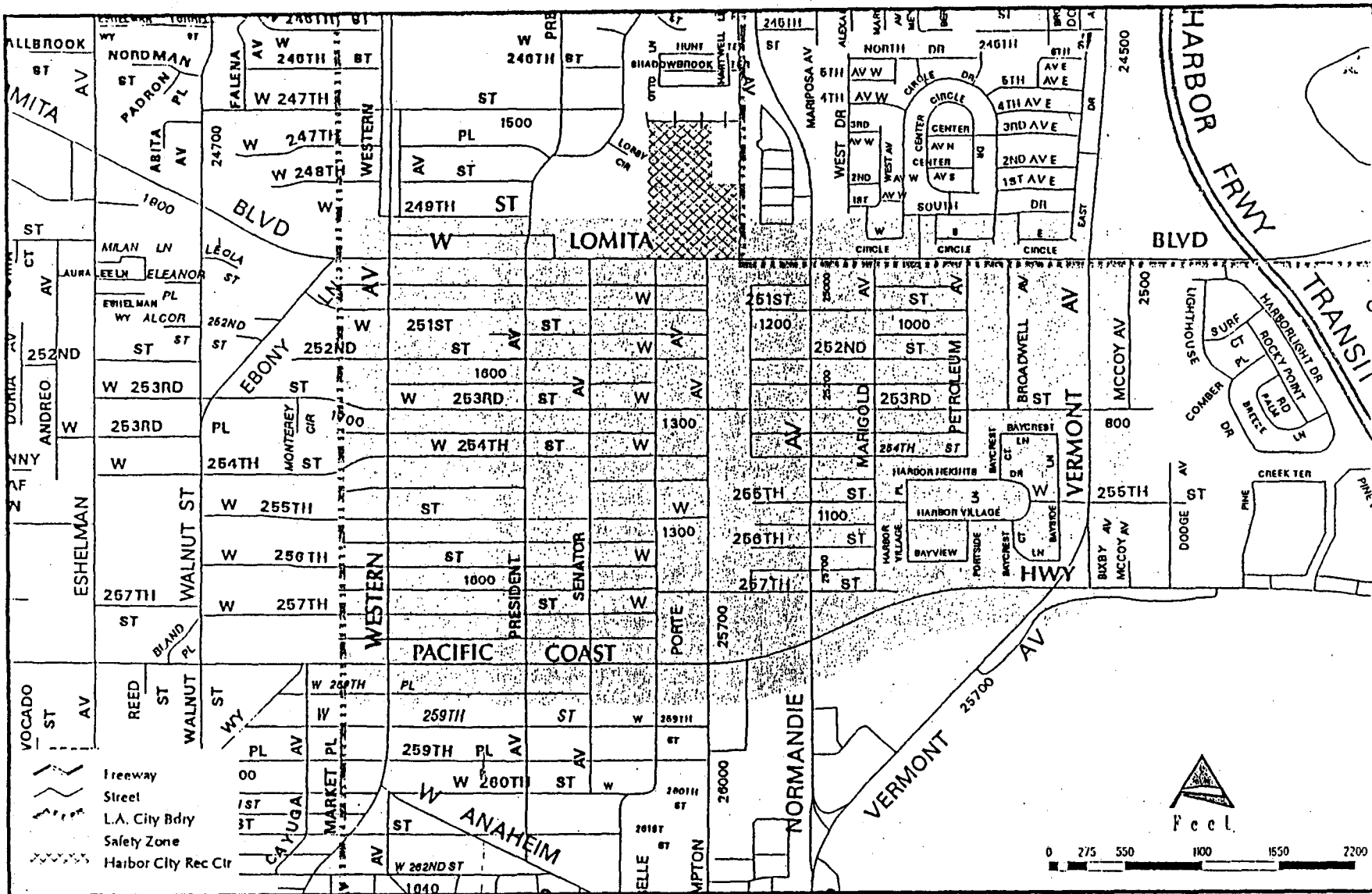
14 d. **No Drug Sales Activities:** As a pedestrian, approaching, signaling, talking to
15 the occupants of, or blocking the movement of, any vehicle except a police car or public bus on any
16 street unless a legitimate emergency situation requires;

17 e. **Stay Away From Alcohol:** Anywhere in public view or anyplace accessible
18 to the public, (1) possessing an open container of an alcoholic beverage, (2) knowingly remaining in
19 the presence of anyone possessing an open container of an alcoholic beverage, or (3) knowingly
20 remaining in the presence of an open container of an alcoholic beverage;

21 f. **No Trespassing:** Being present on any property not open to the general
22 public, except with (1) the prior written consent of the owner, owner's agent, or the person in lawful
23 possession of the property or (2) in the presence of and with the voluntary consent of the owner,
24 owner's agent, or the person in lawful possession of the property;

25 g. **Don't Act as a Lookout:** Acting as a lookout, whistling, yelling or otherwise
26 signaling another person to warn of the approach or presence of a law enforcement officer;

27 h. **Obey All Laws:** Failing to obey all laws (1) which prohibit violence and

Safety Zone Map



2 prohibit interference with the property rights of others including trespass, theft, vandalism and
3 driving without the owner's consent, and (3) which prohibit the commission of acts which create a
4 nuisance including the illegal sale of controlled substances and blocking the sidewalk;

5 3. No Costs Plaintiff waived costs. Each party shall bear its own costs in this action.


