Accommodations and Modifications at School and in the Classroom for Students with Visual Impairments

Accommodations

- * Additional desk or workspace
- * Use of magnification device
- * Instructional aide as needed
- * Task lighting at desk
- * Guide for field trips and emergency school drills
- * Assistance when getting on and off the bus
- * Assistance in cafeteria
- * Provide assignments in advance for brailling or enlargement
- * Order standardized state tests in advance in appropriate media
- * Provide TVI with texts for next school year by April so they can be ordered in appropriate media
- * Auditory copies of texts
- * Braille materials
- * Large print copies of texts, maps, worksheets, handouts
- * Tactile materials and manipulative as needed
- * Storage for braille and large print materials, texts, manipulative in classroom

- * Speech access software
- * Enlarged computer monitor
- * Braille translation software
- * Slate and stylus
- * Peer notetakers
- * Printer in classroom for access technology
- * Braille embosser and other specific braille materials
- * Copies of boardwalk at desk
- * Assistive technology
- * Permit use of cap and dark lenses in classroom
- * Provide copies of texts for home
- * Reading stand at student desk
- * Provide materials free of glare and visual complexity
- * Verbal and/or written description of movies, PowerPoint, pictures
- * Orient student to classroom and school at beginning of school year
- * Provide quiet space for TVI pull-out instruction

Modifications

- * Extended time for tests
- * Testing in a quiet environment
- * Provide oral directions for tests
- * Shorten assignments
- * Preferential seating in room and during assignments
- * Permit student to move close to board and demonstrations
- * Provide additional time for visual and verbal response
- * Verbalize all information on board
- * Permit student to take tests orally
- * Permit student to leave class early to change classes
