

RIDGEPORT TO THE FRONT AGAIN.

Aviation Week has brought out numerous miniature aeroplanes exhibited up and down Main street, but the most novel one is in the show window of the Davis & Hawley jewelry store, 996 Main street.

Mr. Molnar, a native of Austria but a resident of Bridgeport for the past twelve years, has invented a wing flying machine, model of which will be on exhibition this week only at Davis & Hawley's.

The motion is exactly like the wings of a bird; when the up stroke is made, the wings are arranged to turn to offer the least possible resistance to the air. On the down stroke, the wings spread, carrying the aviator up, forward, sideways, in circles, or any direction at will. This can be done by the manipulation of the several levers which are under complete control of the operator.

This machine will be cheerfully exhibited to anyone interested to see this most novel machine which may prove to be the greatest flying machine of the future.
