

# 3 New Schools Approved

Construction of three new schools in the Davis District is scheduled to begin by July 1. They are to be ready for occupancy by the fall of 1963, according to Supt. G. Harold Holt. A site for a fourth school was also determined this week.

THE SCHOOL board approved preliminary plans for a 13-room elementary school to be built on the east bench of Bountiful at 500 South just above 1300 East. It will be named the Oak Hills School. Preliminary sketch was submitted by Robert L. Springmeyer, a Salt Lake architect.

It is planned that seven rooms will be added to the school almost immediately after this first phase is completed.

THE BOARD also decided on a name for another elementary

school to be built on a site just west of highway 91 on the Syracuse road. It will be called the Vae View Elementary and will house students from north Layton and south Clearfield.

The first phase of construction of a new high school to be built in Bountiful on Tenth North, is also scheduled for completion by the beginning of the 1963 school year.

FOR THE FIRST two years it will house ninth and tenth grade students to alleviate the overcrowded conditions at both the Bountiful High School and the junior high schools in the south end of the county. By the fall of 1965, it is scheduled to become a full-fledged high school. No name has been chosen for it yet.

The school district recently received \$980,029 from the federal government under Public Law 815. This grant will be used to defray a little more than half the cost of building the first phase of the new high school.

THE BOARD also made a definite agreement with Sunset City concerning an exchange of services between a proposed

junior high school and a city park.

The school district owns a tract of land in Sunset adjacent to a site which the city is planning to develop as a city park. The school site is not large enough for a junior high which is a need of the area in the near future. So, Sunset City has agreed to allow the school's students to use the park for athletics and residents will have some recreational use of the school in conjunction with the park.
