

# ADDENDUM TO F-29 RETALIATOR FOR THE AMIGA/ST

## **I. Corrections to reference card**

- A. Selecting weapons with the SHIFT key and weapon keys do not apply to the Amiga version. Press the ENTER KEY.
- B. Reconfiguring the mouse to emulate the keyboard command does not apply to the Amiga version.
- C. Pressing SHIFT with the "+" and "-" keys to double the RPM's increments and decrements does not apply to the Amiga version.
- D. There is no Auto Pilot feature.
- E. There is no Break Lock Feature.
- F. The Multi Function Displays (MFD) will only cycle from the keyboard and not the keypad.

## **II. Corrections to the Manual**

### **A. Page 6, The Enrolment Data Bank**

Here you enrol in the USAF and select your rank. The ranks are available from lowest to highest as follows: First Lieutenant, Captain, Major, Lieutenant Colonel, and Colonel. The higher the rank you select, the more variety of missions will be available. More points are awarded to the higher rank for the same mission. Missions will also be harder (see scoring). Sign in and click OK or ENTER to confirm your name.

### **B. Page 7, Main Selection Screen**

LOAD PILOTS LOG, selection of this option will load the previously saved pilots log.

### **C. Page 9, Weapons and Stores**

Armaments may also be selected and deselected by clicking on the weapon name.

### **D. Page 30, Level Wings**

This command will only level the wings and not revert the aircraft back to level flight from stalls.

### **Page 35, Horizontal Situation Radar (HSR)**

Blue and green dots will appear on the HSR. Blue dots are enemy targets and threats below your aircraft. Green dots are threats above your aircraft.

### **Page 38, Lift**

Increasing speed will not cause aircraft to lift.

### **Page 39, Altitude**

52,000 feet is the maximum altitude of the ATF
