BEFORE BOOTING YOUR PROGRAM PLEASE READ THIS NOTICE

The Amiga VIRUS is a small program that could reside on the boot block of one of your Amiga disks. If you boot one of these 'infected' disks, the computer will become 'infected' with this VIRUS.

The VIRUS program loads itself into protected memory, and usually will not affect the normal operation of the AMIGA. But next time you insert a disk into the drive, the VIRUS will check it to see if it is 'infected' and if not it will write itself onto that disk. This could eventually 'infect' all of your disks. The VIRUS will not be destroyed by warm booting the AMIGA (i.e. Pressing Control-Amiga-Amiga).

This VIRUS can render some commercial disks UNBOOTABLE. We cannot be held responsible for disks that have been damaged in this manner.

PREVENTION

Where possible, write protect your disks by sliding the write protect tab back, this will stop the VIRUS from writing onto that disk. If the program requires that you have the write protect off, you should power down the system, and then restart before booting your disk.
