The two men in the **Team Pepsi – Suzuki** are racing in the 1988 **500cc World Championships**, a series of at least fourteen races spanning three continents. Both **world-class riders**, they are Kevin **Schwantz** of the **USA** and Rob **McElnea** of **Great Britain**.

McElnea, born in 1959, has now completed **10 years** of racing. Successful in the Isle of Man **TT races**, he then turned his attention to the **Grand Prix** circuit. In 1984, he **won** the prestigious Classic TT on the **37.73 mile** Mountain circuit and, a year later, scored a double victory for **Suzuki** by winning both the **Classic** and the **Senior TT** races. His hobbies include trials riding and golf.

Kevin **Schwantz** is regarded as one of the **hottest** racing prospects for many years. The 23 year-old **Texan** is to mount his first full **500cc World Championship** campaign in 1988 – just **two** years after making his Grand Prix **debut**. A former professional **motor-cross** rider, he has already made a huge **impact** on both sides of the Atlantic, in the American **Superbike** Championship and the **500cc World Championship**. His hobbies include golf, watersports, shooting and ski-ing.
