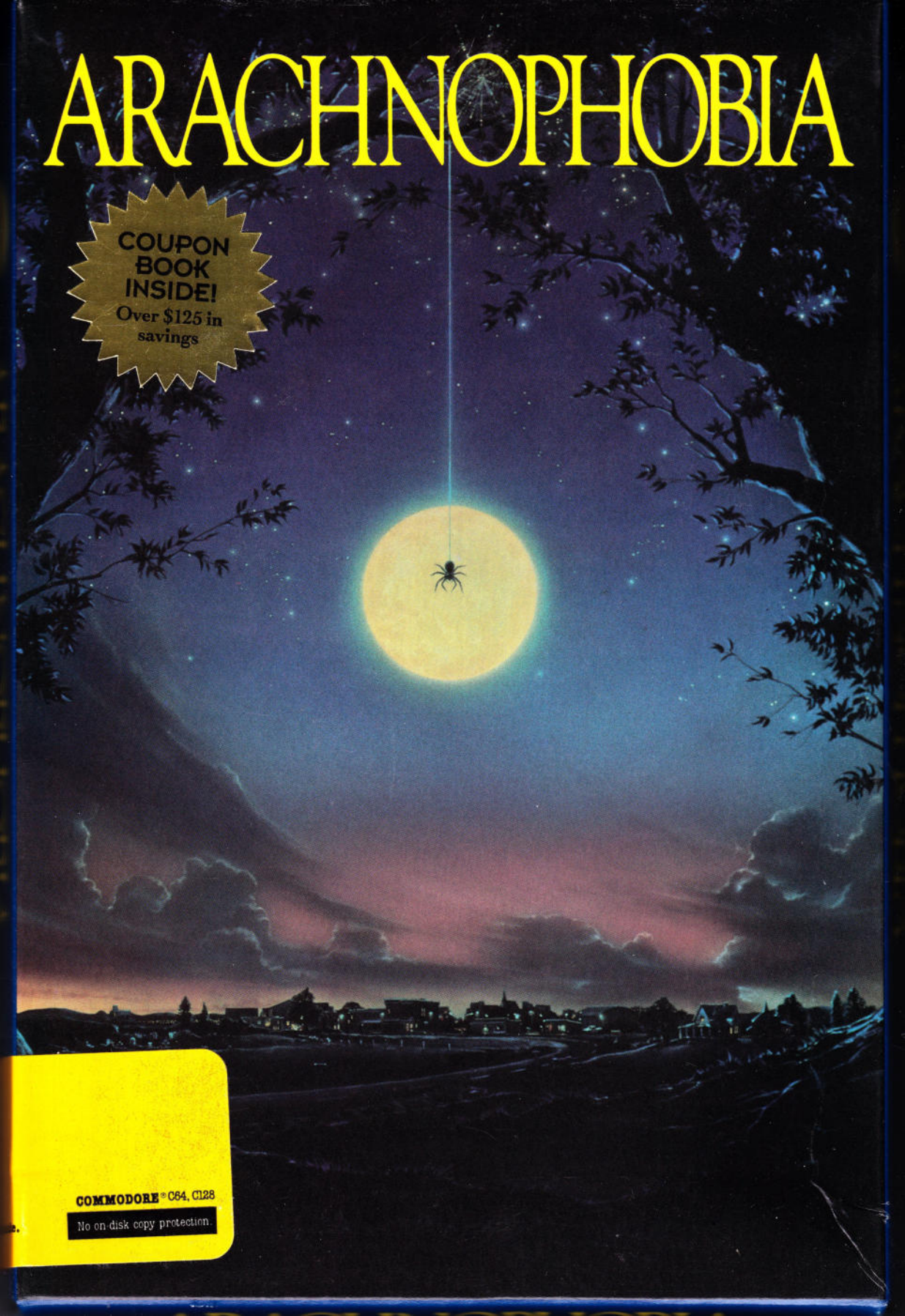


ARACHNOPHOBIA

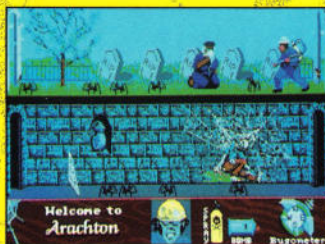
