COMMODORE LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

Press SHIFT and RUNSTOP together then PLAY on the recorder.



On loading you will see the screen CASSETTE TEXT LOADING. Now turn the tape over and press REWIND. When the tape has stopped rewinding press N or A and press PLAY on the tape recorder to load FILE A. Make sure the tape stops between each question file. You can then begin to test your TRIVIA knowledge against the top machine in the arcade.

After selecting either a 1, 2 or 3 player game, the main game screen will appear with your starting 80p credit. There are six different question cards which are randomly dealt on the screen:

SCROLL	Arts and Literature
TEST TUBE	Science
MUSICAL NOTES	Music
CAMERA	Film and Television
SNOOKER TABLE	Sport
GLOBE	History and Geography

The cards are selected by highlighting and pressing FIRE within the time limit.

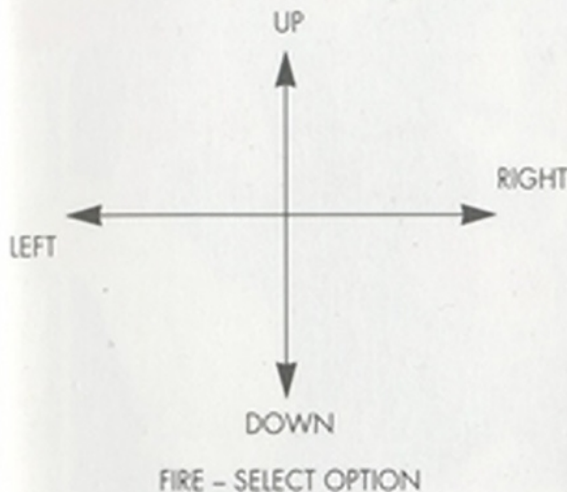
The question then appears on the screen and you must select an answer from the possibilities given without running out of time. If you correctly answer the question, you can move onto the next row of cards. An incorrect answer means that you have to either RESTART or CONTINUE at the cost of 20p.

Your financial success improves as you answer more correct questions, and the expressions on the faces of the contestants reflect your success or failure.

If you manage to answer questions all the way up to the top card, you may enter the big money CASH RUN.

When a JACKPOT question appears, a correct answer allows you to take your winnings or risk your stake on a chance of doubling your money.
