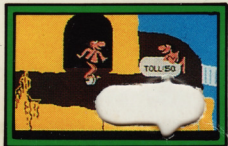

HINTS & TIPS

Thor has completed the Quest For Tires, and must now find the Meaning of Life, which is hidden away in a maze of mountains. The mountains are joined by bridges, and to cross these, Thor must pay a toll of 100 clams, which he can collect along the way. He will have to avoid rocks, potholes and Tire-dactyls (they'll eat his wheel), and must never enter the same screen as the mighty Grog. He can plan his route up the mountain by using the preview screen in the bottom right hand corner of the screen. Grog is shown as a diamond and Thor is shown as a square. In each level is a Warp Cave, where by typing in two numbers, (which ones? That would be telling!) Thor can go straight to the next level. In other caves it is pitch black so Thor has to use his Headlight to avoid stalagmites and to pick up clams.

CONTROLS

To load BC II: Grog's Revenge type SHIFT and RUN/STOP.

Use Joystick in Port 2. Move around the screen in all 8 directions, and use the fire button to go faster.
