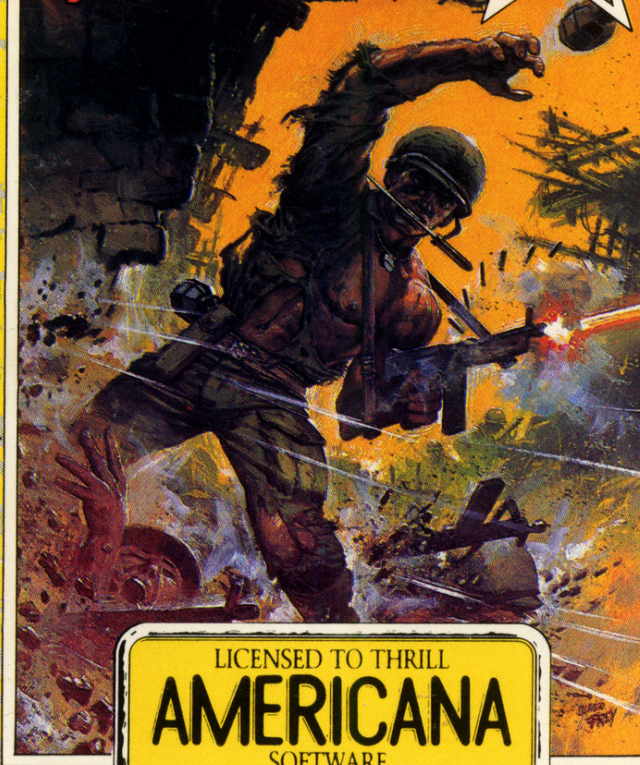

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LOADING

Press SHIFT and RUN/STOP keys together. Press PLAY on the cassette recorder. (If you are using a C128 make sure in C64 mode).

INTRODUCTION

BEACH HEAD II is a true "Head-to-Head" two player multi-sequence game that allows you to play against another person or the computer. You can choose to play either of the characters.

SCORING TIPS:

In general, higher scores will be obtained at higher playing levels.

ATTACK SCENE

ALLIES: points are awarded for objects destroyed and hostages saved.

DICTATOR: his only opportunity for points comes by destroying the chopper and any hostages on board.

PLAYING THE GAME

Choose level with function key.

Select mode, normal or practice.

In the normal mode you play the screens in order, practice allows you to play any screen. During play you can change sides at the start of any screen, other than Escape - where you must play the Allies - by changing joystick.

Joystick in Port 1 controls the Dictator, Port 2 for the Allies.

Options

T displays top ten. N shows your ranking.

To clear top ten press the Commodore key, Run/Stop, and Q simultaneously.

D starts demo - you can start playing against the computer at any time.

CNTRL aborts game. O switches voice off. I switches voice on.

CONTROLS

Attack ALLIES - control helicopter with joystick.



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
