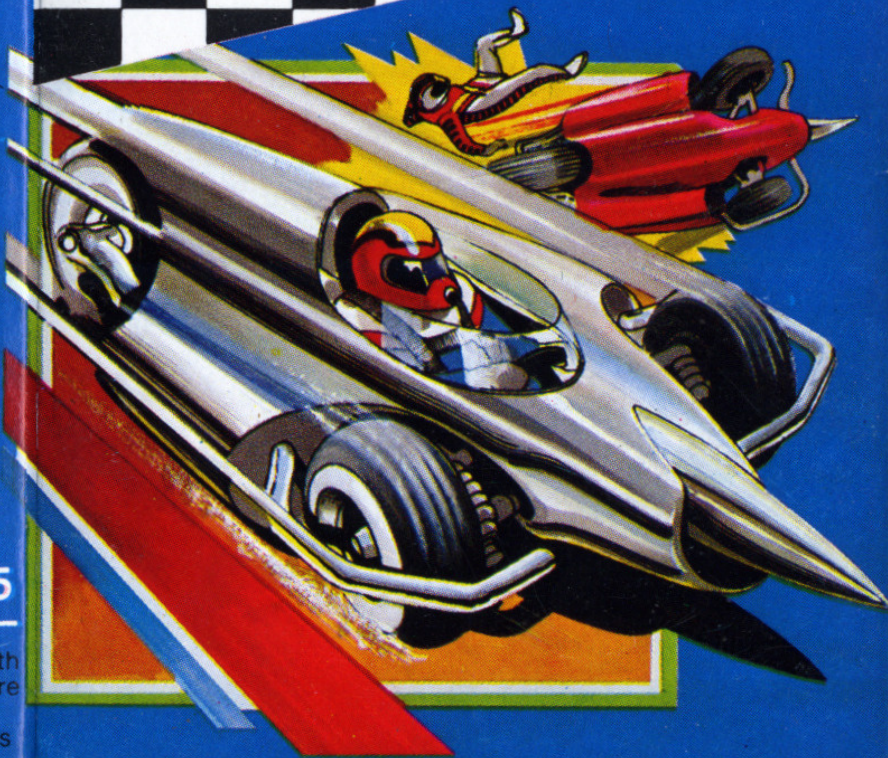

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BURNIN' RUBBER

You are an entrant in the great Intergalactic Four Seasons Death Race! You must tackle the Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter sections with the objective of running as many other cars as possible off the road. The opposition is numerous and dangerous, including the slow but indestructible Tank Cars, the tricky Deathmobiles and many other Demon Drivers. You have only three lives, but you do have one advantage - your car can fly for a limited distance, allowing you to avoid obstacles if you're quick enough! All this and more makes Burnin' Rubber the car race of the century!

Load the program as normal, and it will load and run itself automatically. Warning - this program contains a lot of code and takes over ten minutes to load, so a bit of patience is required. Make yourself a cup of tea or read your favourite computer magazine! (If you get a load error, the system will reset instead of displaying the error.) When the title screen comes up you will see the scoring system and keyboard controls displayed. Make sure your joystick is plugged into Port No.2 and press the Fire button for the next screen which gives you the game instructions. Set your playing level with the f7 key, press f1 or f3 for one or two players (in the two player game the players play alternately), and then off you go!

Control Keys....

J or FIRE button	=	FLY
f1	=	One Player Game
f3	=	Two Player Game
f5	=	Music On/Off
f7	=	Set Level
SPACE BAR	=	Pause and Restart

After each game you can enter your score into the high score table, assuming that you scored a high score, by using your joystick or keyboard controls to position the red cursor over three initials in turn - press the Fire button or 'J' after each one to enter your selection. If you enter one wrongly you can delete it by selecting RUB. Select END when you have entered them correctly, then move the stick forward or press 'P' to get back to the title page.

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Before loading any program, please ensure that the heads of your cassette deck are clean and demagnetised.
