Start A New Game

Loading EOS — Be sure you have a blank, formatted disk with ID "EA" on hand before you start a new EOS game. To do this, put the blank disk in your drive and type

OPEN 15,8,15,"NØ:NAME,EA":CLOSE 15

and wait for the drive light to go off.

Insert your EOS game disk in your disk drive, and turn on the computer. Type **LOAD "EA",8,1** to start loading the program. In a few moments, the title screen appears, followed by a menu that asks if you are starting a new game or resuming an old (saved) game. Press Return or the joystick button to select **New Game**. At the prompt, insert the Archive Disk, then press Return. The Archive disk contains program information for starting a new game.

Make a Mission Disk — Each new game requires a new Mission Disk, where you'll store your game as it progresses. Select **Make M disk**, and press Return. A prompt asks you to put a formatted blank disk in your drive, and press Return. It takes about nine disk swaps to copy the disk. When the copy is complete, put the original Mission Disk in a safe place: you'll need it again whenever you start a new game.
