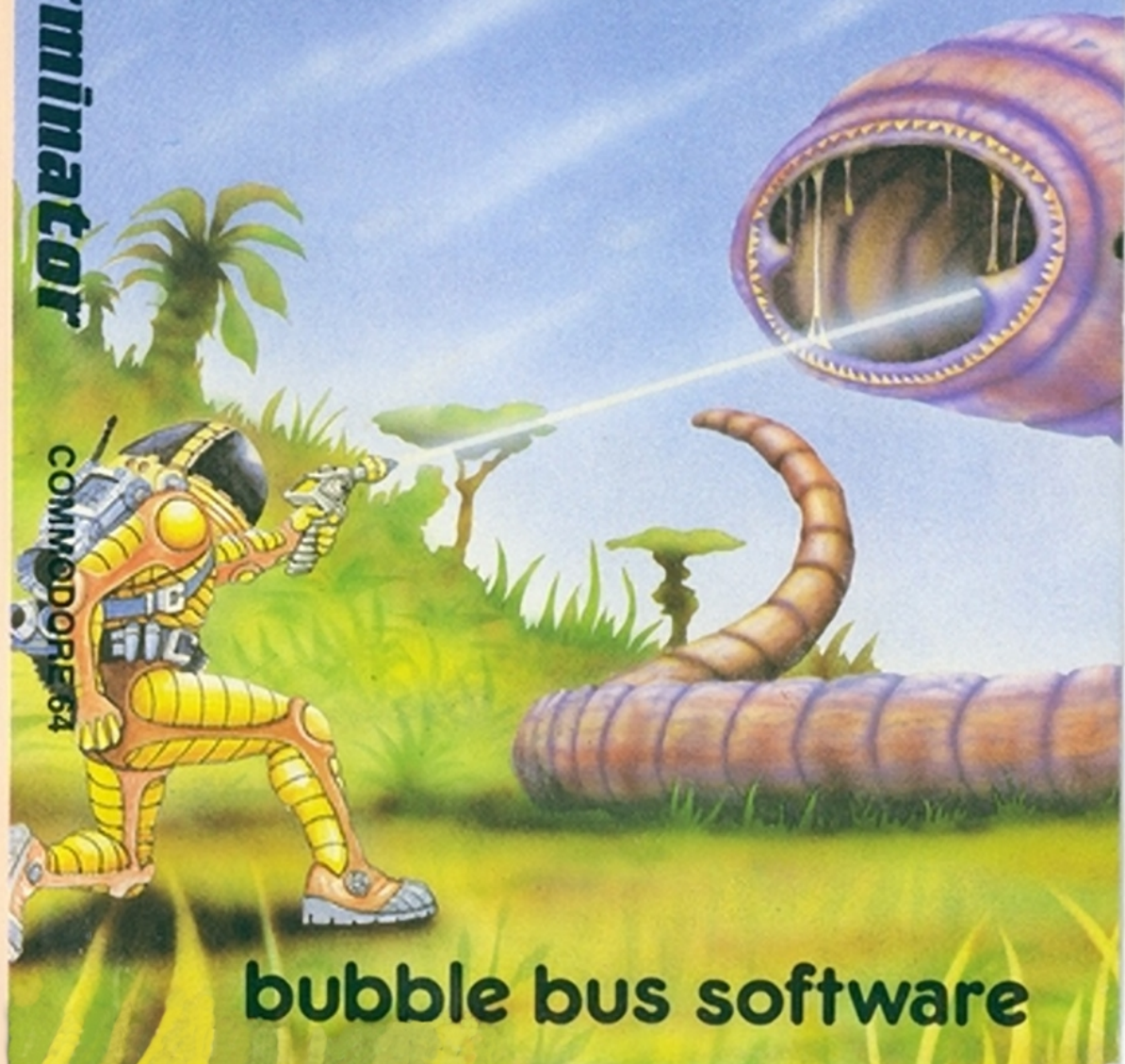

Loading

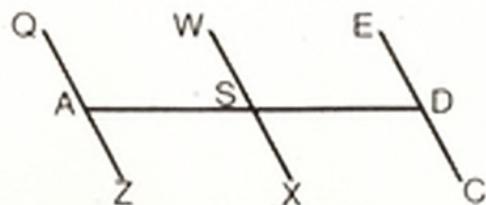
Turn computer on and insert tape. Ensure tape is rewound to start. Press and hold down shift key then press and release the run/stop key. Now release shift key and press 'play' on tape. Exterminator will then be automatically loaded and run. Exterminator is on both sides of the tape.

Play

Shoot everything that moves, and everything that doesn't (except the spider). Follow the instructions on the screen to enter number of players etc. Extra men are awarded and the game speeds up as you proceed. F5 will turn the sound on and off. F7 will freeze and unfreeze the action. Restore key will restart game. GOOD LUCK.

Joystick in port 2 for 1 player game. Use both ports for two players.

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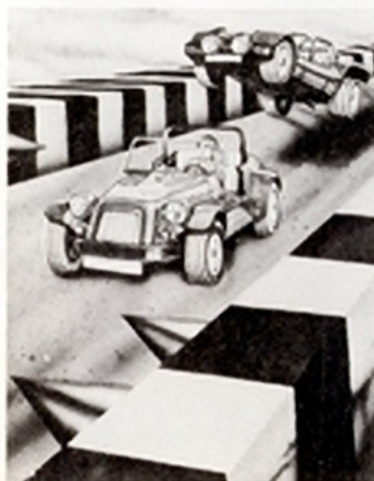
