One

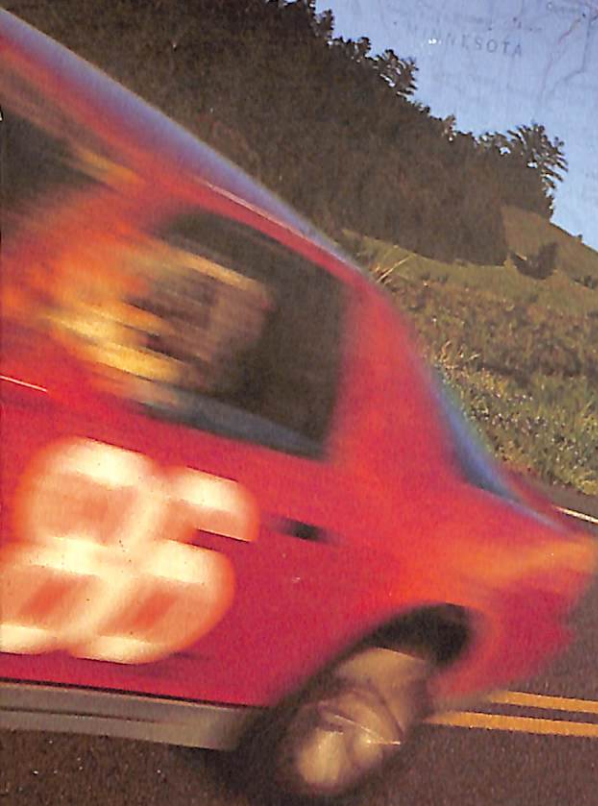
