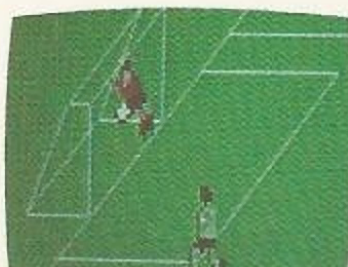
Defense and ball movement are important elements in this game as the defensive player attempts to head off an offensive thrust at midfield.
