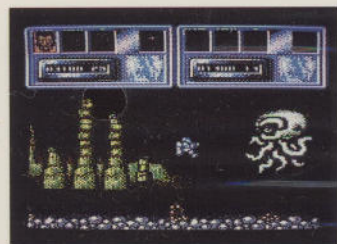
Your visor reflects the criss-cross glows of needle-sharp laser beams that seek to vaporize your jetpack. You wonder if you'll survive — much less succeed!

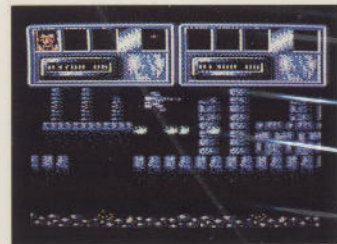
It's time to stop daydreaming and save the moons of Saturn before it's too late!
