When a machine is complicated then it's faults can seem like a personality.

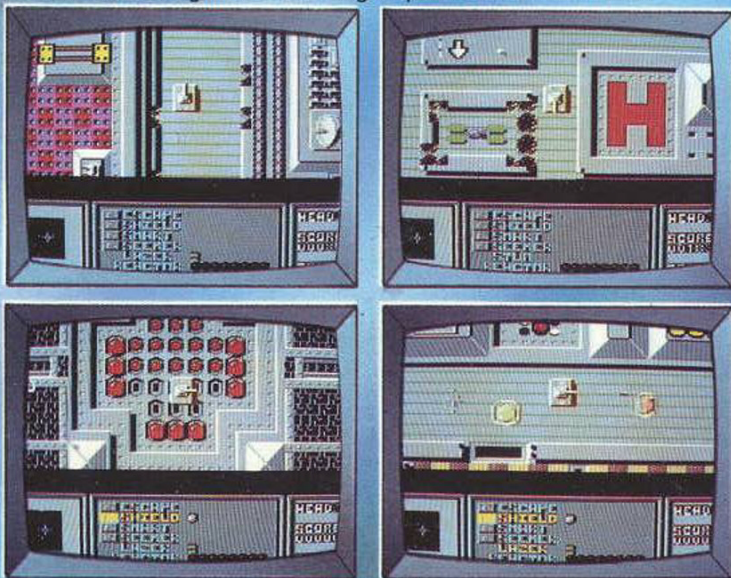
