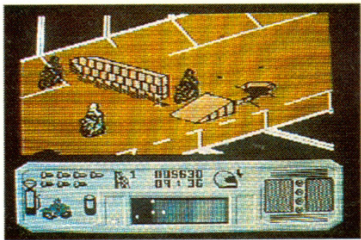

Loading

Tape: Press shift and Run/Stop and press Play on the tape recorder.

Disk: Type LOAD "*" , 8, 1 and press RETURN

Mean Streak is a one or two player game, so you can either fend off the computer's Outcast bikers, or fight it out with your best friend.

The Prize

This is your chance to win that super-bike. The first step to becoming the ultimate biker is to survive all five hazard-ridden levels of the Battletack.

When (if) you get that far, follow the on-screen instructions and you could win a fabulous mountain bike worth £400.

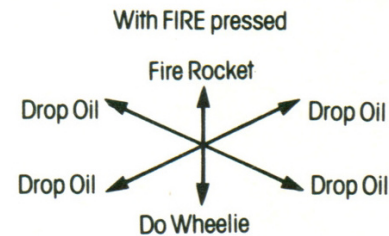
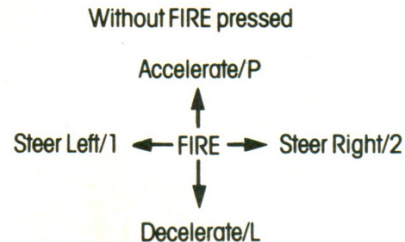
Starting

When the game has loaded, an option screen is displayed which allows you to select the number of players and control options:

Press 1 for 1 player game
Press 2 for 2 player game
Press 3 for 1 player joystick (Port 2)
Press 4 for 1 player keyboard control
Press 5 for 2 player joystick control (Player Two Port 1)

Press F1 for Music during game, F3 for Sound Effects

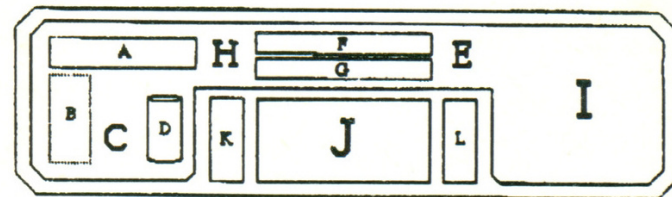
Now press Fire (or Space in keyboard mode) to start.

Playing Tips

Extra Fuel, Oil, and Missiles can be picked up from the track. Keep an eye on the timer... extra seconds are awarded for destroying Outcaster bikes. Oil and Ice will make you skid, while other elements may wreck your tyres. Mind the edges of the Battletack — although Outcast bikes can be nudged into them. Watch out for walls — they're fatal unless blown to bits! Good luck on the Battletack, you'll need it!!!
