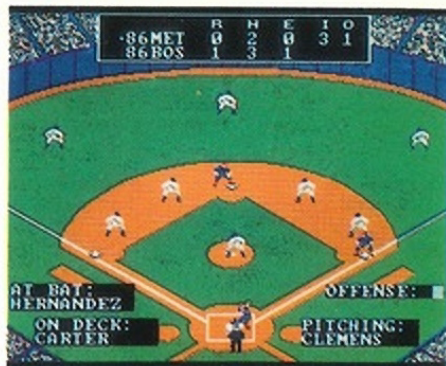


MICRO LEAGUE Baseball

General Manager/ Owner's Disk

This disk makes you the boss—trade & draft players (with a reserve list feature), change rosters and update players' stats as the season progresses, bring up rookies—even create your own team. You can tap any roster on any MLB TEAMS Disk or roster included on the MLB GAME Disk—then after copying the roster over to the GM/OWNER'S Disk, wheel & deal, change the roster as you want, "saving" the newly created or revised roster for you to play in the MLB Game.

With the General Manager/ Owner Disk you can:

- Trade players between teams.
- Hold a Drafting session with your friends, and pick your players. Great for League play!
- Give players their Unconditional Release—or send them to the Reserve List.
- Create your own fantasy "dream teams", with players from any team, any era.
- Make up your own players, or bring up rookies from the minors or bring back players from retirement.

This disk is to be used only with rosters on the Game disk, or rosters from any type of MLB Special Edition or Season Team disk, Franchise History Disk, or Stat Compiler Disk.

- Update & revise stats for any player as the season progresses.
- 32 team/roster slots available in memory, with ability to delete teams.
- Best of all, use the rosters you've created or placed on the GM/O disk in any MLB Game!!

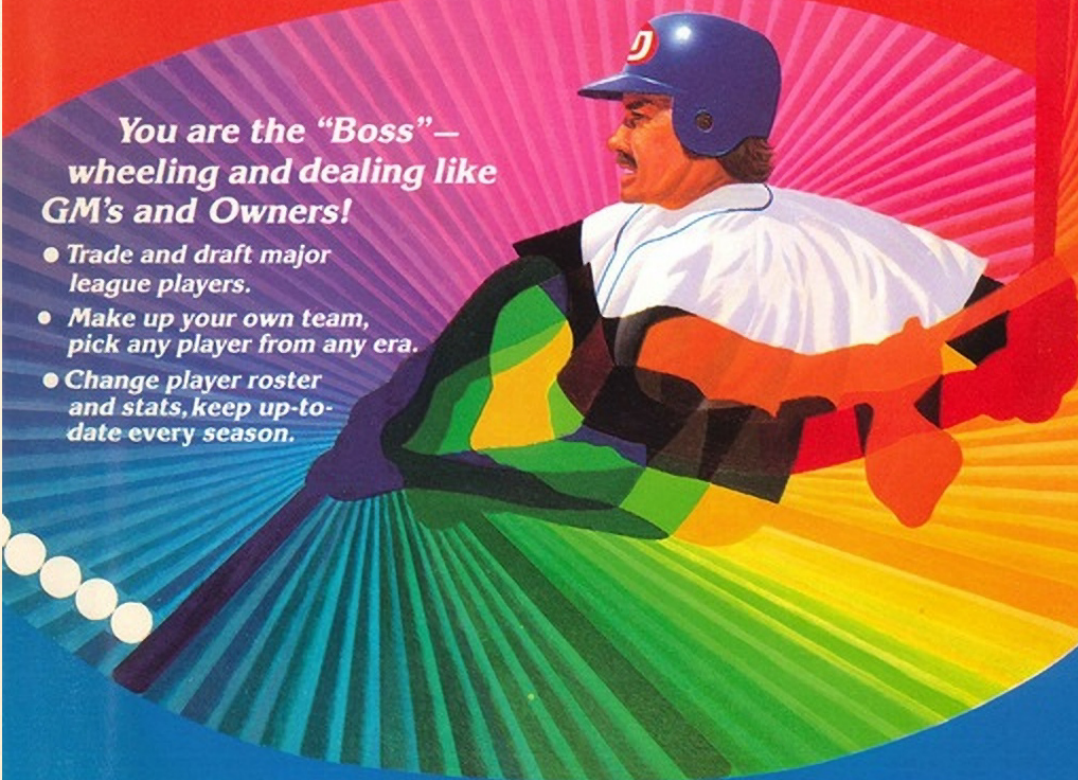
