CASSETTE LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

This cassette includes a fast loading routine which considerably reduces the time taken for the cassette to load.

Switch the computer off and remove any cartridges.
Connect a C2N Datasette Unit, do not connect joystick(s) until after the game has been loaded.

Switch on, put cassette in the Datasette Unit and fully rewind tape to the left.

To run the program press and hold down SHIFT then press RUN STOP. Start the tape as prompted.
The game is recorded in four sections.

The program will take about 7 minutes to load.



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
