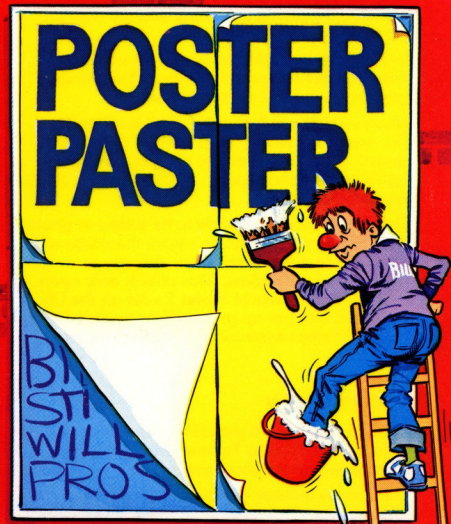

POSTER PASTER INSTRUCTIONS

STARRING BILL STICKERS

LOADING

1. Start with computer switched off. Remove all cartridges and peripherals except joystick (port 2), tape machine and TV lead. Then switch ON.
2. Check tape is fully rewound.
3. Hold down SHIFT press RUN/STOP. Press play on the tape machine and the programme will load and auto-run.

NOTE

The high speed loader PAVLODA has been used to reduce the loading time to about 4 minutes. It is normal for PAVLODA to produce a very colourful screen while loading.

SETTING UP

1. Use joystick port 2.
2. Use full volume control on TV or monitor.
3. The full range of player options is included. During the idle mode pressing any key will take you to the options page.
4. Press fire to PLAY.

THE GAME

Help Bill pick up all the papers for the poster and paste them on the hoarding. All the hoardings in town need doing. But hurry or Bill Stickers will be prosecuted.

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REGISTRATION

The registration card should be completed and posted (Free Post) to Taskset Limited as soon as possible to register your ownership of the game.

The unique number on this instruction leaflet becomes your Registration Number. Keep it safe.

As a registered Taskset game owner you are entitled to a 10% discount on your next game purchased direct from Taskset.

STARRING BILL STICKERS

THIS IS WHAT YOU DO . . .

In Poster Paster you, as Bill Stickers, make your way through the town pasting posters on every available hoarding. The poster is made up of a number of pieces of paper. As you begin each new hoarding you will have with you a box of papers, a paste bucket and a ladder.

Use the fire button to lift the roll of paper from the box when Bill's outstretched hand is over the one you wish to take.

Decide where this sheet of paper fits in the poster, this is easy if you are in Phase 1 and its position in the box should have given you a clue.

Bill cannot paste the sheet unless he is on the ladder. To pick up the ladder walk along the gutter until you reach it and it will then go with you until you move up or down.

As you climb the ladder position the roll of paper where you think it ought to fit. Press fire to paste it onto the hoarding. If it's in the right place it will stick otherwise it won't.

Keep sticking sheets in their correct place until the poster is complete.

THINGS TO STOP YOU DOING IT . . .

Gnurds, Wazzocks and Drain Brains populate the town, contact with any of them is fatal. Flicking paste at them will keep them at bay. The paste sets off just right for sticking. If it gets too runny nothing will stick. If too thick it will be hard to flick off your brush. Any passing fully loaded aquatic wazzock could thin your paste until it's useless but an undisturbed bucket load will quickly coagulate.

A tall ladder is needed to reach tall hoardings. A tall ladder becomes a short ladder if the ladder shrink button is activated. A short ladder becomes a tall ladder at the next pressing.

HINTS AND TIPS . . .

Keep an eye on the paste consistency gauge (PCG), if it's getting too runny you are not shooting enough wazzocks.

Your precision pasting bonus (PPB) will be reduced at any inaccurate pasting. The bonus is awarded at the end of each phase.

When you are up the ladder don't lean too far and watch out for the drain brain. If you really haven't got the hang of any of it yet then select EASY in the options page. If you're getting cocky select HARD.

There is, of course, a riddle to be solved in phase 12. The first player who can solve the riddle will be invited to demonstrate their skills at our expense here at Taskset. This offer is only open to registered owners of Poster Paster on the UK Mainland. Runner-up prizes will be awarded and winners' names announced in the Computer Press.

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
