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Loading Instructions:

Insert the cassette with the label facing upwards and ensure that the tape is fully rewound.

Hold down the SHIFT key and press RUN/STOP. Press PLAY on the cassette recorder. When the game has finished loading remember to press STOP on the recorder.

The Game:

Stock Car is a car racing game for one or two players with a choice of 6 different circuits to race around, variable skid (0 - 99%), selectable number of laps (1 - 40) and oil patches. The computer controls the two yellow cars (three in the one player game).

Each car has 4 gears and the race starts with the cars in neutral. Your gear and the number of complete laps are displayed at the top of the screen as well as your speed in the form of a horizontal bar. In each gear you have a different acceleration and top speed. Remember to go down to first or second gear if you crash.

The winner of each race can put his name on the hi-score table. If the loser gets the best lap time then he/she is asked to enter his/her name as well.

Game Controls:

Plug a joystick into port 2 or use the following keys:

	White Car	Black Car
Left		SHIFT (R)
Right	SHIFT (L)	
Shift up		F5
Shift down	CTRL	F7

'R' Restarts the program.

DELETE allows you to change the parameters for the race.

If you have any problems:

There are two copies of the program on the cassette. If you cannot get the second version to load try cleaning the recording head using a cotton bud dipped in head cleaning fluid or Isopropol Alcohol. If the message 'Bad Load' appears try moving the recorder further away from the television set. If you still cannot get the program to load reliably then return the cassette to us for a prompt replacement, stating when and where you bought it.

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
