GAME: Musical Chairs

BEST TIME TO PLAY: Anytime

OBJECT OF GAME: To be the last person sitting.

- * Chairs are placed in a circle. Every chair has a Sight Word or a Word Family Word taped to it.
- * Music before 1979 is playing when kids are walking in circles.
- * When the music stops, every child sits. Unlike traditional musical chairs where there is one fewer chair than students.
- * The teacher (or student acting as the teacher) shows or speaks the randomly selected word from a deck. Whoever has that word attached to their seat must wall sit until the end of the game.
- * Winner gets a point.
