

d + id = did



**Did is the tense
past of do.**

d + id = did

Do

Present tense

To perform an action.



For example:

- I **do** the laundry.
- They **do** their work.
- She **does** the dishes.

Did

Past tense.

An action that has already happened.



For example:

- He **did** the laundry.
- You **did** your work.
- We **did** the dishes.

Done

Past participle.

We add an auxiliary verb.



For example:

- I have **done** the dishes.
- He has **done** the work.

d + id = did



Verb: do



Do means: to perform an action

V1	V2	V3	V4
Do	Did	Done	Doing

Synonym: carry out, undertake, discharge, execute

Examples:

- 1) **Do** well is better than say well.
- 2) What **did** you get for your birthday?
- 3) Nothing is ever **done** in a hurry.
