





Hill



- A natural mound of earth created either by faulting or erosion.
- A “bump” in the landscape.
- Lower altitude and elevation, with a rounded top.
- Often unnamed.

Mountain



- A natural mound of earth created by faulting.
- A steep rise in the landscape.
- Higher altitude and elevation, with a defined summit or peak.
- Often named.
