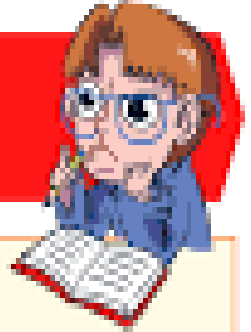


g + ot = got



Verb: get



Get means: to receive, obtain or buy something

Get	Got	Gotten	Getting

Synonym: obtain, come to have, receive, gain, earn

Got is an irregular verb.
