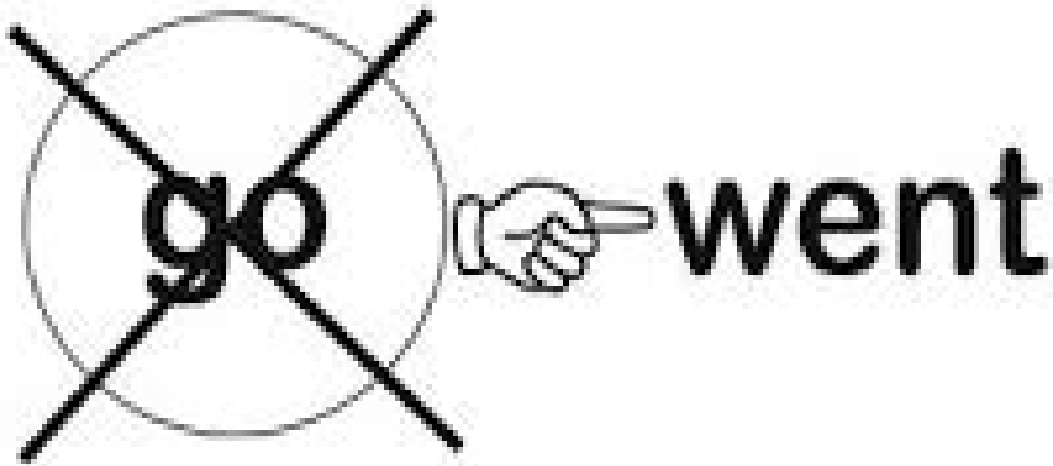

Go

Base form.

To move from one place to another.



For example:

- I **go** to school.
- They **go** to the shop.
- She **goes** to the park.

Went

Past simple.

An action that has already happened.



For example:

- He **went** to the park.
- You **went** to school.
- We **went** to the club.

Gone

Past participle.

We add an auxiliary verb.



For example:

- I have **gone** to school
- He has **gone** to the cinema.

The verb went is past tense.
