GOOD vs. WELL

GOOD modifies things.

We tend to use them interchangeably, but they aren't really interchangeable.
Here are examples of how to use them correctly.

WELL modifies actions.

- The food is good.
- She feels well.
- She feels well because she eats good food.

Good luck. Now you'll use well, well.

Common English Error GOOD vs WELL

Always use WELL after a verb.

- X I did **good** on my exams.
- I did well on my exams.

GOOD should never be used as an adverb.

- X He plays the guitar good.
- ✓ He plays the guitar well.
