Much vs. Many



We use much before noncount nouns.



Much VS Many

We use "much" with uncountable nouns and "many" with countable nouns in questions, affirmative sentences and negations

Example:

How much money have you got?
I don't have many friends.
It's too much honey in my tea.

We also use "a lot of" or "lots of" in the affirmatives with both countables and uncountables

Example:

There is a lot of/lots of milk in the jug.

There are a lot of/lots of people in the room
