

WHEN VS WHILE

When can be used as an interrogative adjective, relative adverb and a conjunction.

When can refer to actions that take place at the same time or an action that immediately follows another.

When does not indicate a contrast.

When is used to talk about ages and periods of life.

While can be used as a noun and a conjunction.

While can refer to actions or situations that take place at the same time.

While can be used to indicate a contrast.

While cannot be used to talk about ages and periods of life.
