GAME: Negotiate a deal with synonyms and antonyms.

BEST TIME TO PLAY: Synonyms and Antonyms

## OBJECT OF GAME: To get a complete set of cards.

- \* Print, laminate and cut the four pages of synonym and antonym pictures. (Some words do not match the images that well. However, it makes it easy for little kids to match the pictures.)
- \* Each student gets an equal amount of cards. It is not necessary to use all the cards.
- \* Each student may want to use their whiteboard and Blue Tack (a reusable sticky putty) or cardboard and tape to organize their images.
- \* Students must trade with their classmates.
- \* Students can use their fake money to trade. The only rule is to be polite. Any rude student will not get any fake money or points.
- \* This game teaches kids more than synonyms and antonyms; it teaches them patience and how to negotiate a deal.
- \* I give kids 10 fake dollars for a complete set of 7 cards. Also, the person who has the most cards gets 10 fake dollars. Whoever has the fewest cards owes 5 fake dollars.
- \* Use a timer if you desire. This game can take a I-o-n-g time!
