popcorn- one type of corn. Water inside a kernel turns to steam when heated; it pops into a snack!

acorn- a nut from an oak tree.

born- coming to life, birth.

worn- past participle of wear, clothing or jewelry on one's body.

torn- past participle of tear, to rip.

thorn- a sharp point found on some plants and trees.

horn- bone growing from the head of some animals; rhinoceros grow a horn on their nose! Unlike antlers, horns are permanent.

Also, a musical instrument (French horn).

In addition, a device on vehicles that makes an annoying sound and lets other people know you are impatient.

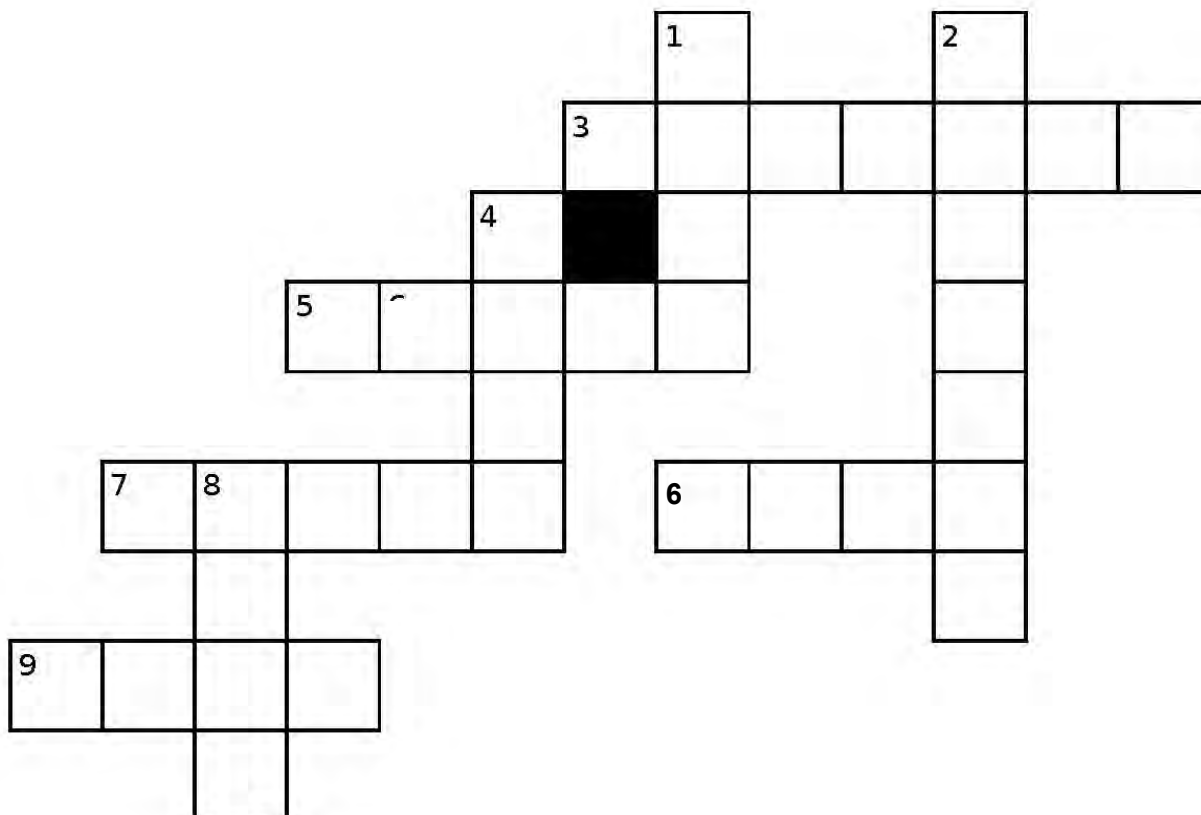
