ring- jewelry on one's finger. Also, the sound of a telephone. In addition, an area enclosed by ropes where people compete (boxing).

king- a man, by birthright or given, who rules a country.

sing- one's voice used as a musical instrument.

sting- a bee's (wasp, etc.) reaction to a threat.

swing- to move back and forth.

wing- allows most birds, bats and insects to fly.

bring- arrive at a destination with something or someone.

ping-pong- another term for table tennis.

Be sure to stress that many words ending in "ing" make the /ēn/ sound, such as writing.

demanding- takes large amounts of time or mental focus.

accepting- to consider fair.

overreacting- respond in a manner more than necessary.

boxing- a sport where two combatants inside a ring wear padded gloves (8-20 ounces) and punch each other.

living- alive.

Depending on a person's dialect or region, they may not pronounce the final "g" of a word. People repeat the sounds they hear.



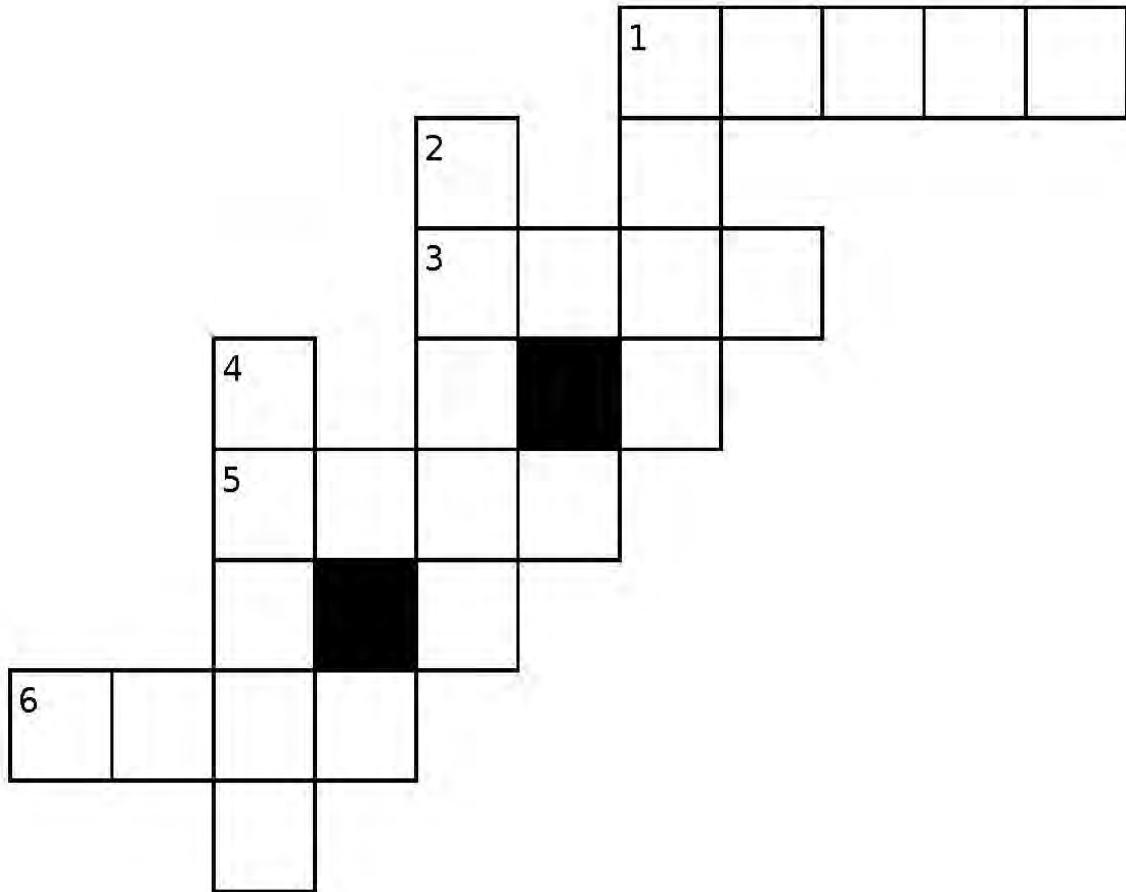
