The friction match was invented in 1826. Wood or paper sticks with a match head (sulfur, potassium, etc.) at one end, ignited when rubbed against a surface (silica, etc).

patch- cover a hole with a material.

catch- grab and hold a moving object.

batch- a group of things.

scratch- scrape the skin.

sketch- a fast preliminary drawing.

stretch- something increases in length when pulled.

crutch- a "stick" with padded support under the arm for people who struggle to walk.

latch- device to keep a door closed.

hatch- a door on an airplane. Also, to emerge from an egg.

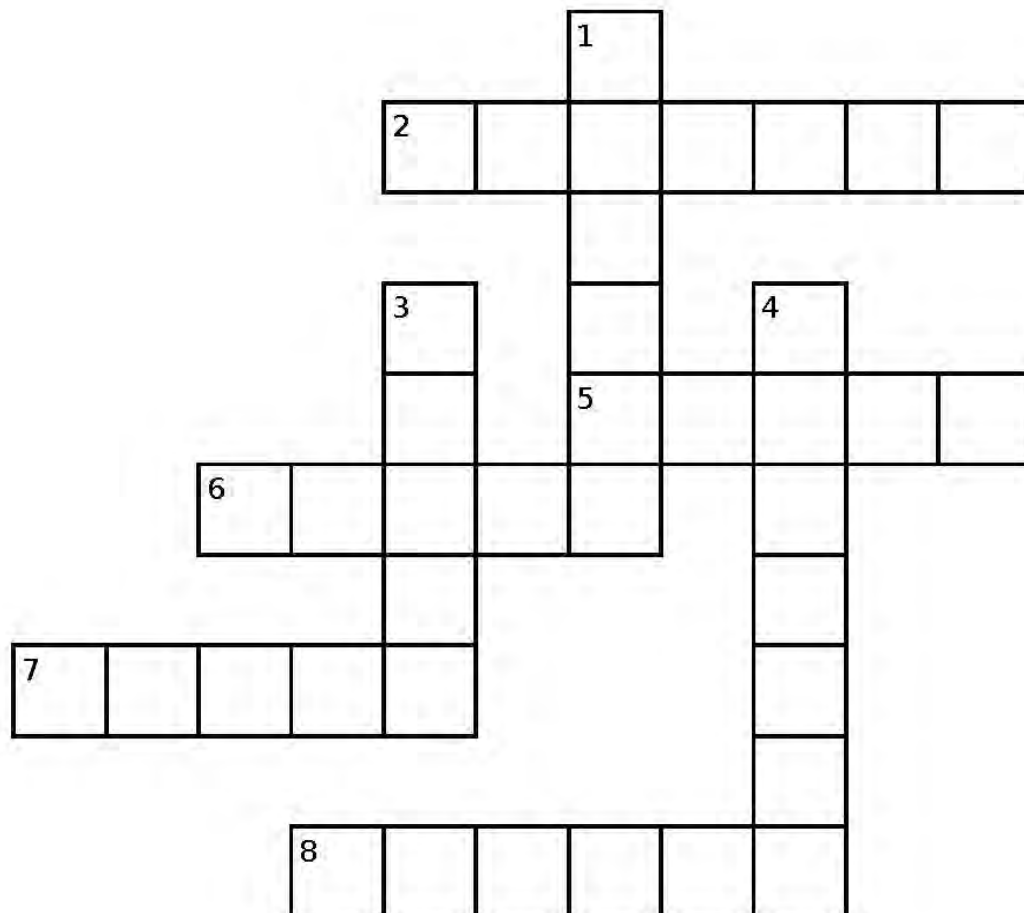
