

#177 eer

deer- 47 species of this mammal. Male deer grow new antlers each year; a few species of females grow antlers. Moose are the largest members of the deer family.

reindeer- live in northern parts of the world. Same species as caribou, but different subspecies.

steer- controlling the direction of a vehicle. Also, young male cattle that had been "fixed", called an ox at age 4.

veer- quickly change direction.

jeer- insult, imitate in a rude manner.

sneer- ridiculing another for something. Usually backed with a facial expression of disgust.

cheer- an expression of approval (clapping hands).

career- a person's profession.

volunteer- someone who helps out without getting paid. Also, a person who chooses to join the military and gets paid.

engineer- a vague term for someone who designs, constructs and maintains many things (buildings, highways, chemicals, computers, video games, etc). They take science and math then apply it to the wants and needs of humanity.

beer- an alcoholic beverage.

peer- an equal person (age, abilities, etc).


