

## #84 ey

**key**- a small piece of metal with cut notches to unlock (door) or start something (car).

**money**- currency (coins or bills) to pay for goods or services.

**turkey**- a bird with no teeth and two stomachs, some can fly.

**donkey**- an animal resembling a small horse with large ears. A male donkey (jack) and a female horse can make a mule. A female donkey (jenny) and a male horse can make a hinny. Donkeys can also produce offspring with zebras.

**journey**- traveling.

**jockey**- a smaller person who rides horses in races.

**kidney**- pair of small organs protected by ribs that keeps your blood clean, eliminating waste through urine.

**alley**- a narrow road, usually behind buildings.

**valley**- low land between mountains or hills.

**chimney**- a hollow (brick) chamber that allows smoke to be released outside. Also, a place where Santa enters the house as he doesn't have keys.

*Exceptions to the rules include the words obey, they, prey, etc.*

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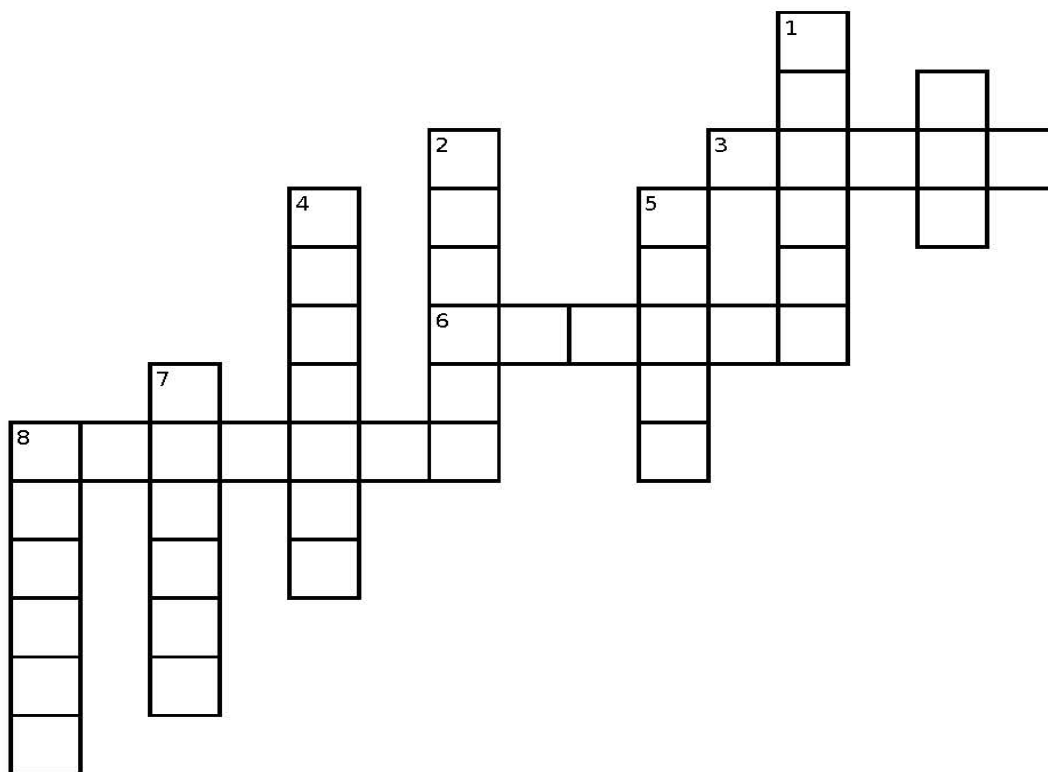
