wind (long i) = twist or turn. Remember, the prefix "un" means "not"; therefore, **unwind** is the opposite of wind (twist or turn).

wind (short i) = movement of air.

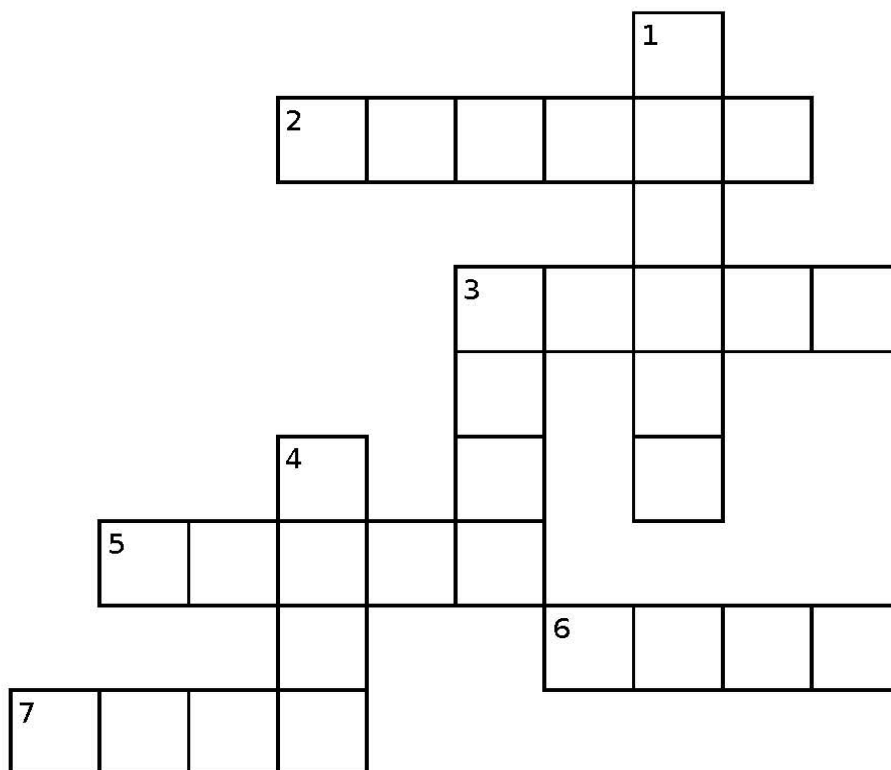
