The "ose" pattern can make the long $/\bar{o}/$ sound (dose) or the /oo/ sound (lose or whose).

* I hand-picked my favorite lesson on the nose. Try this with your students as a group activity or teams of two. One student holds their nose and closes their eyes while a classmate gives them a jellybean or another treat with a variation of flavor. The student holding their nose must point to the correct flavor listed on a flip chart while they hold their nose. Use the number of correct vs incorrect answers for a math lesson during literacy and science! Lesson learned, flavor derives from taste and smell. The tongue can taste, but to truly experience the flavor ones nasal passages should not be blocked.


