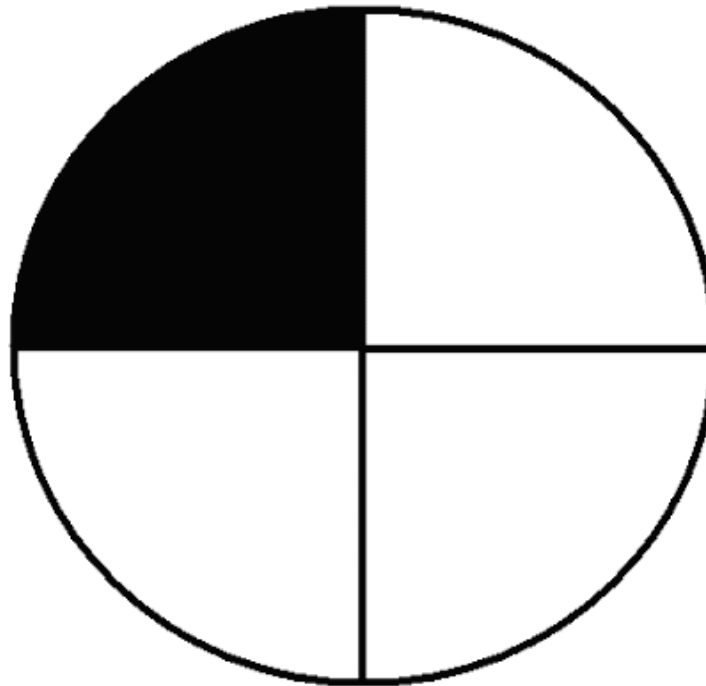

(noun) Most of the class did a good job.

## #102 **cost** (verb)

The books cost (*price*)  
ten dollars apiece.



(noun) They gave me a free straw  
at no extra cost.

# #103 **lost** (adjective)

Past tense and past participle of lose.

I was lost

*(not knowing where  
someone or something is)*

**in the woods.**

# #104 **lose** (verb)

Did you  
lose

*(unable to find)*

your keys?





loose

# #105 **loose** (adjective)

He lost weight, and now  
his pants are loose (*not tight*).



Can be other parts of speech.

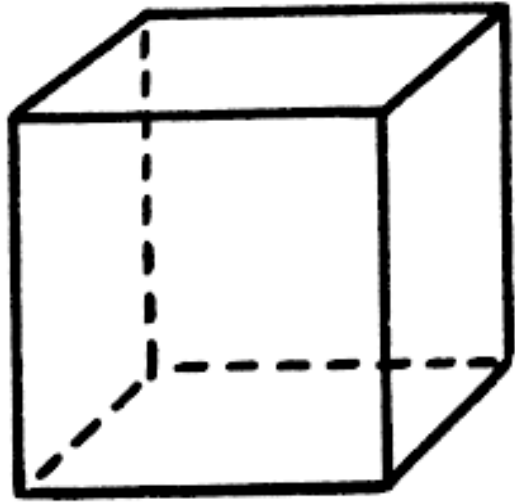

**#106 use (verb) /yōōz/**

**Use (*put into action*) an eraser  
if you make a mistake.**

**(noun) /yōōs/**

**He put it to good use  
(*a way of using something*).**



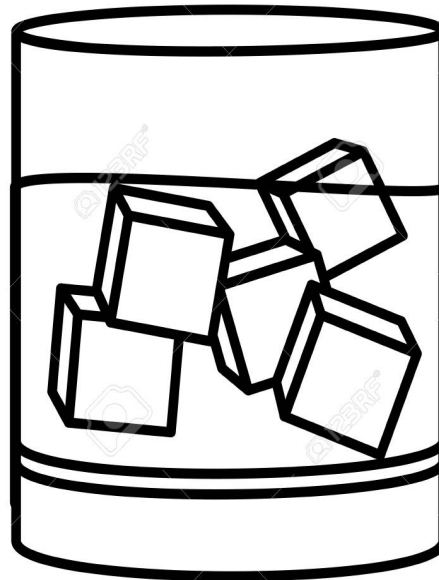
cube

**Please put another cube**

**(a 3D [three dimensional] square)**

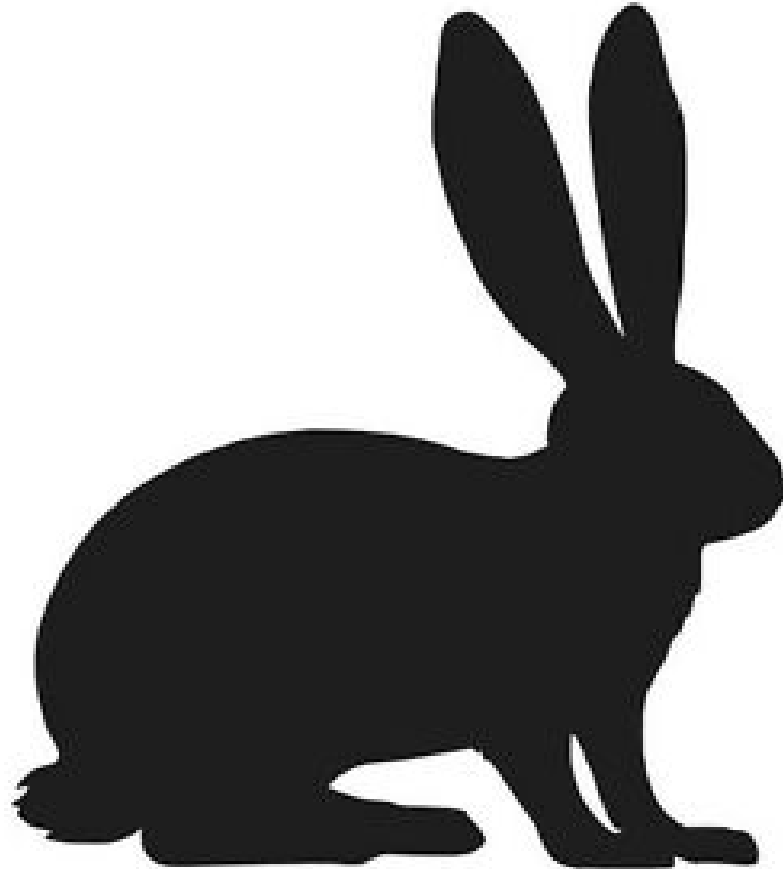
**of ice in my drink.**

#108 **cute** (adjective)

This is a **cute** (*attractive*) **bunny**.

## #109 **mute** (adjective)

Press the mute (*lessen the sound or unable to speak*) **button** on the remote control.

# #110 **duty** (noun)

It is your duty (*a legal or moral obligation*) to help.
