

He ate the most (majority) pie.




(noun) Most of the class did a good job.

in the woods.




#104 lose (verb)

He lost weight, and now his pants are loose (not tight).




Can be other parts of speech.

(a way of using something).




#107 **cube** (noun)

(a 3D [three dimensional] square)


of ice in my drink.
