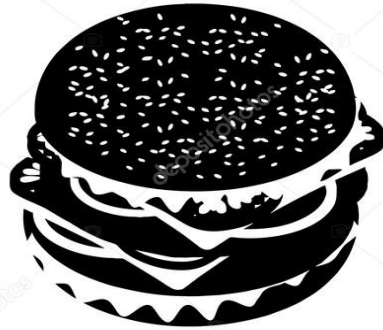

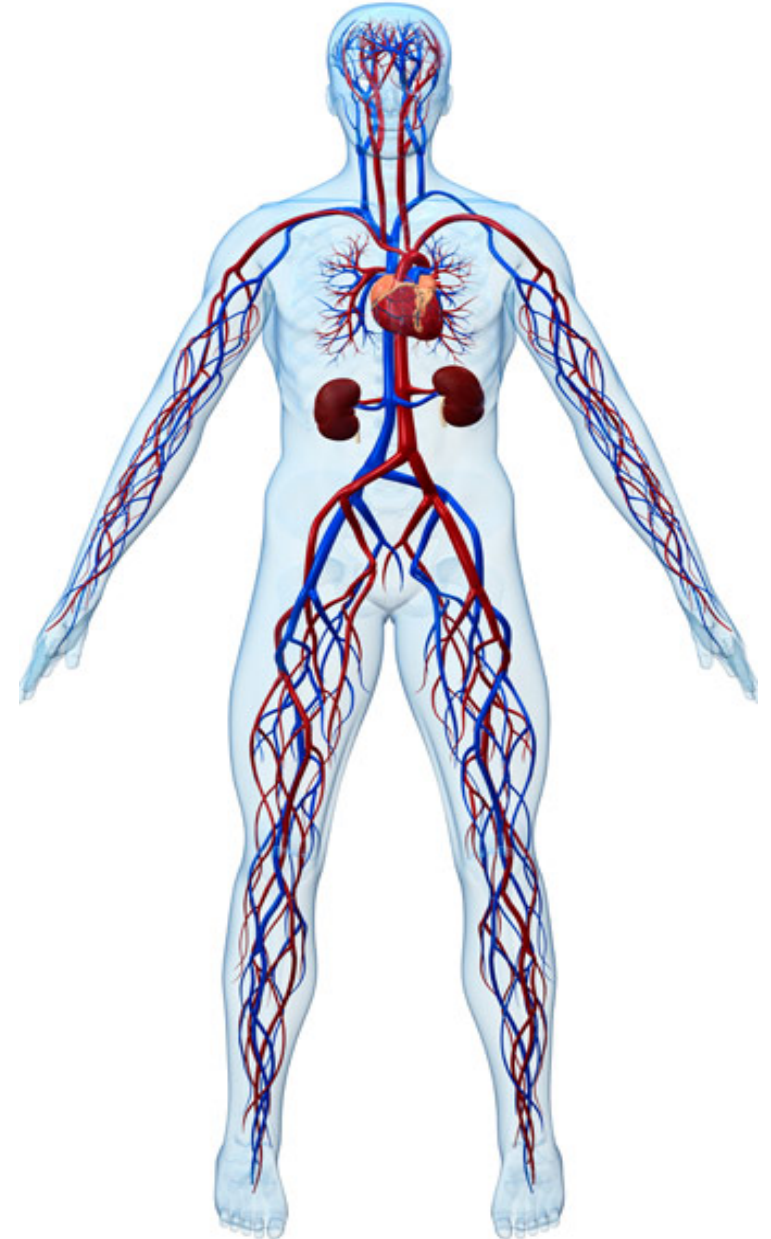


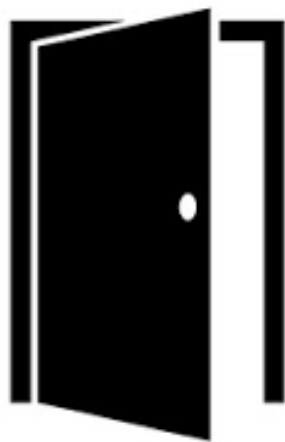

the body.**

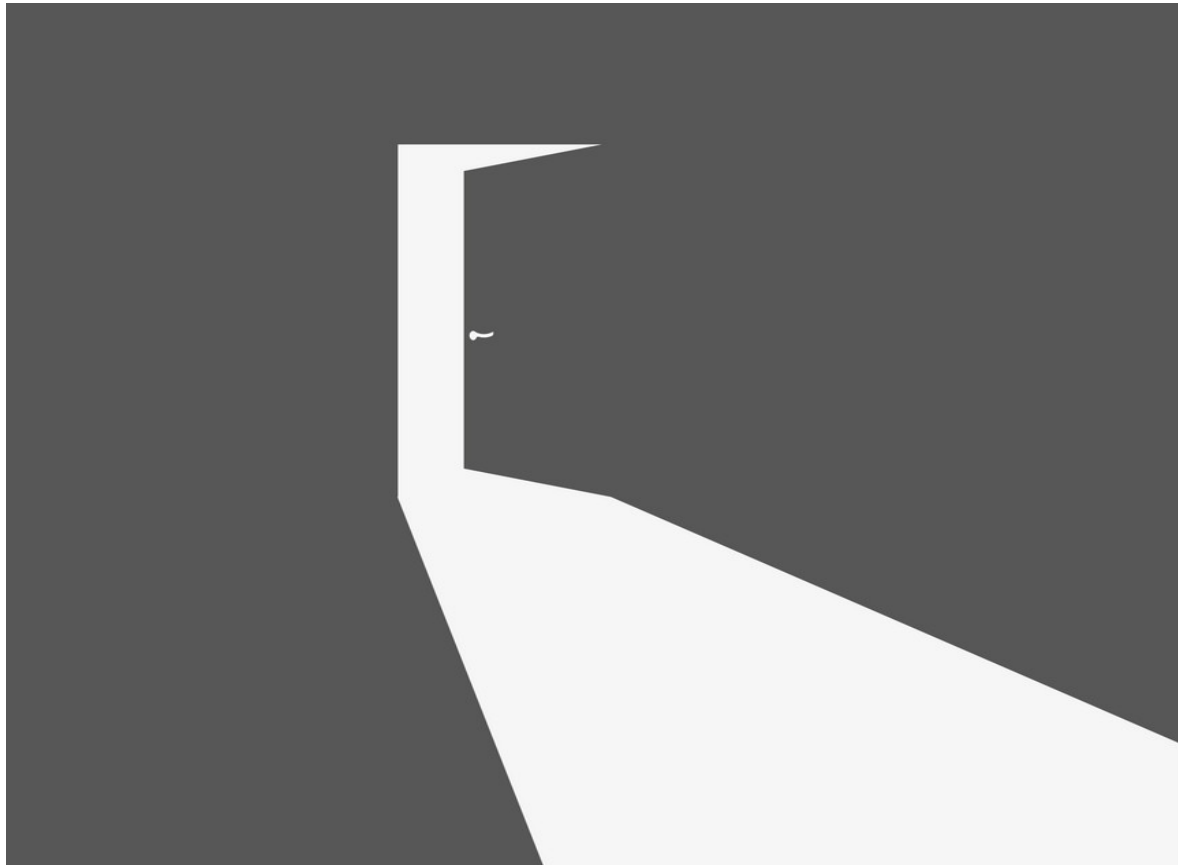
