

#131 hair (noun)


Hair can grow up to 15 cm (fifteen centimeters/six inches) a year.






#132 ear (noun)

Elephants have the biggest ears.







Smile

Brush your teeth after every meal.






cheek

#135 cheek (noun)


He has puffy cheeks.






#136 chin (noun)

Below my lips is my chin.






mouth
